1. Load Factor Rebate / Surcharge:

1.1 Voltage-wise graded load factor rebate applicable to the Industrial consumers will be as per the following table:

1.2 Load factor surcharge shall be levied on industrial consumers if the load factor falls below 30%. The surcharge for the load factor less than 30% but equal to or above 25% shall be 5 paise / kWh for the amount of energy by which consumption falls short of energy corresponding to a load factor of 30%. The surcharge for the load factor below 25% shall be 10 paise / kWh and shall be applicable only for the amount of energy by which the consumption falls short of energy corresponding to a load factor of 25% but not less than the amount of surcharge that would have been payable for load factor at 25% computed @ 5 paise / kWh.

2. Power Factor Rebate/Surcharge:

The rate of rebate and surcharge and the methods of calculation of such rebate and surcharge are given below:

3. A rebate shall be given @ 1% of the amount of the bill excluding meter rent, taxes, duties, levies and arrears (not being the arrears due to revision of tariff) if the payment is made within the due date.

4. In addition to the rebate under paragraphs 3 above, If the payment is made within due date, then an additional rebate of 1% of the amount of the bill excluding meter rent, taxes, duties, levies and arrears (not being arrears due to revision of tariff) would be allowed to the consumers who would pay their energy bills through e-payment facility (through web by using net banking, debit card, credit card, electronic clearing scheme. These rebates are applicable after giving effect to the rebate under paragraphs 3 above.

The above competitive rates shall come into effect from the consumption month of September '2026.

The new consumers of above categories supplied at 11 KV shall apply to the office of the respective Regional Manager, and those supplied at 33 KV, 132 KV, and 220 KV and above shall apply to the Chief Engineer (Commercial) to comply formalities in order to avail the above-mentioned rate.

For the new applicant, the application received upto 15th of every month(n) will be considered in (n+1) billing month and received after 15th of every month (n) will be considered in (n+2) billing month.

The rebates as allowed vide order dated 08/02/2017 of WBERC and notified by WBSEDCL on 10/02/2017 shall not be applicable for the consumers availing above rate.

The above competitive rates shall be reviewed and notified as and when tariff/ FPPAS rates for consumer of different licensee operating in the above areas will be revised.

This notification has been issued with the consent of the Government of West Bengal following the direction of the Hon'ble Commission.
