Charging infrastructure will play a pivotal role on EV deployment. Financial

The Applicant Firm should have a Minimum Average Annual Turnover (MAAT) of Rs. 1,00,00,000.00 (Rupees One Crore) in any three available financial years out of last five Financial years and a positive net worth as on date of bid submission. Annual Accounts to be duly certified by a Chartered Accountant. The above MAAT of Rs. 1,00,00,000.00 (Rupees One Crore) is applicable upto 5 locations. Beyond 5 locations, Rs. 20,00,000.00 (Rupees twenty lakhs) for each locations should be added with Rupees one Crore.

Failure to furnish all information required by the Bid document or submission of a Bid not substantially responsive to the Bid document in every respect will be at the Bidder's risk and may result in the rejection of their bid.

5. CLARIFICATIONS ON BID DOCUMENTS

- 5.1. A prospective Bidder requiring any clarification on Bidding Documents may notify the Owner through e-mail (e-mail id: ceprojiii@wbsedcl.in). WBSEDCL will upload in the website/issue corrigendum in the website/issue instructions in the website to any request for such clarification of the Bidding Document which it receives not later than the date indicated in Section-IFB and the e-Procurement portal (www.wbtenders.gov.in). Clarifications / Amendments / Corrigendum will be issued through the e-Procurement portal, if found necessary.
- 5.2. A pre-bid meeting shall be held on 15.03.2023 at 11:30 Hours. All the interested bidders who require clarifications on any aspect of this Request for Proposal (RFP), should send their queries through e-mail (e-mail id: ceprojiii@wbsedcl.in) at least three days before the pre-bid conference. Correspondence seeking clarifications received subsequent to the mentioned date will not be entertained.
- 5.3. The queries shall be dealt with at the pre-bid meeting. Based on the outcomes of the pre-bid meeting at any time prior to the deadline for submission of the bid (technical and financial) or extended date, if deemed necessary, WBSEDCL reserves the right to add/modify/delete any portion of this document by issue of an amendment. The amendment will be issued in e-procurement portal and such amendment will be binding on bidders.
- 5.4. Verbal clarification and information given by WBSEDCL or his employee(s) or his representative(s) shall not in any way be binding on WBSEDCL.

6. <u>AMENDMENT TO BIDDING DOCUMENT</u>

- 6.1. At any time prior to the deadline for submission of bids, WBSEDCL may, for any reason, whether at its own initiative or in response to a clarification requested by a prospective Bidder, modify the Bidding Document by amendment (s).
- 6.2. The amendment will be issued in e-procurement portal and such amendment will be binding on them.
- 6.3. In order to afford prospective Bidders reasonable time to take the amendment into



account in preparing their bids, WBSEDCL may, at its discretion, extend the deadline for the submission of bids.

6.4. Such amendments, clarifications, etc., shall be binding on the Bidders and shall be given due consideration by the Bidders while they submit their bids and invariably enclose such documents as a part of the bid.

C. PREPARATION OF BIDS

7. LANGUAGE OF BID

7.1. The bid prepared by the Bidder and all correspondences and documents relating to the bid, exchanged by the Bidder and owner shall be written in the **English language**, provided that any printed literature furnished by the Bidder may be written in another language so long as accompanied by an English translation of its pertinent passages. Failure to comply with this may disqualify a bid. For purposes of interpretation of the bid, the English translation shall govern.

8. LOCAL CONDITIONS

- 8.1. It will be imperative on each Bidder to fully inform himself of all local conditions and factors, which may have any effect on the execution of the Contract covered under these documents and specifications. WBSEDCL shall not entertain any request for clarifications from the Bidders, regarding such local conditions.
- 8.2. It must be understood and agreed that such factors have properly been investigated and considered while submitting the Proposals. No claim for financial adjustment to the Contract, awarded under these specifications and documents, will be entertained by WBSEDCL. Neither any change in the time schedule of the Contract nor any financial adjustments arising thereof shall be permitted by WBSEDCL, which are based on the lack of such clear information or its effect on the cost of the Works to the Bidder.

9. **DOCUMENTS COMPRISING THE BID**

- 9.1. The Bidder shall complete the Bid Form inclusive of Price Schedules, Technical Data Requirements etc. furnished in the Bidding Documents as detailed in clause 3.0 above, indicating for the goods to be supplied and services to be rendered with a brief description of goods and services, quantity and prices.
- 9.2. The Bidder shall also submit documentary evidence to establish that the Bidder meets the Qualifying Requirements as detailed in Clause 11 of IFB document of Contract.
- 9.3. The Bid Security shall be in accordance with Clause 9.0 of IFB.



- 9.4. Bids containing deviations from provisions relating to the following clauses will be considered as non-responsive:
 - a) **Bid Guarantee:** Clause 15, Section II, Volume 1
 - b) Price Basis and Payments: Clause 10, Section II, Volume 1
 - c) The essential minimum qualifying requirements: Clause 11, Section I IFB
- 9.5. The Bidder shall complete all the Schedules & Annexure in the Bid Proposal Sheets, Technical Data Sheets, and Price Sheets (Electronic Mode Only) and specified elsewhere. The Qualifying Data shall be filled in the required Schedule of Techno-Commercial sheets. While furnishing Qualifying Data, only the list of executed Works, similar in nature / Electrical works etc, shall be furnished. Owner's determination of a bid's responsiveness is to be based on the contents of the bid itself without recourse to extrinsic evidence.

10. BID PRICE

- 10.1. The minimum amount for qualification shall be Rs. 1.00/KWH only. Bidding price less than Rs. 1.00 shall be treated as non responsive.
- 10.2. WBSEDCL intends to set-up EV Charging Stations / Battery Swapping stations at WBSEDCL'S own land. The Revenue Sharing on rupees per kWh basis is proposed in the document
 - i. The bidder shall quote "amount in Rs. X per kWh" that will be shared to WBSEDCL. Where 'X' is the highest offer of the bidder and shall not be less than 'Rs. 1.00'.
 - ii. The quoted amount shall be **exclusive** of applicable taxes.
- 10.3. As the tender is floated on revenue sharing basis, the materials required for the execution of work and carrying out operations shall be under the scope of the successful bidder.
- 10.4. Any alteration in the quoted price etc., will not be allowed on any grounds, such as mistake, misunderstanding etc., after the Bid has been submitted.
- 10.5. The bidder will not be entitled for any other charges, allowances or weightages apart from the quoted rates.

11. PRICE BASIS

- 11.1. The bidder must fill the price bid/schedule available along with the tender.
- 11.2. The rupees per kWh for revenue sharing should be exclusive of GST. In case bidder quotes the rates inclusive of GST, quoted rate shall be considered as exclusive of taxes and duties.



12. TAXES AND DUTIES

- 12.1. The prices quoted by the bidder shall be exclusive of all applicable taxes & duties.
- 12.2. Successful bidder shall pay all the statutory levies and taxes imposed by the Government or any other authorities present or future on the operation of EV charging stations.

13. **INSURANCE**

The Bidder's insurance liabilities pertaining to the scope of Works are detailed out in Clauses titled 'Insurance' in Clause 27 of General Terms and Conditions of Contract (GCC) of this Volume I. Bidder's attention is specifically invited to these clauses. Bid price shall include all the costs in pursuance of fulfilling all the insurance liabilities under the Contract.

14. PROVIDING ERECTION TOOLS AND TACKLES

The bidder should clearly understand that all special tools, tackles, cranes and vehicles required for erection of the equipment while carrying out the activities as detailed in the scope of the work shall be provided by the bidder himself.

15. <u>BID GUARANTEE (EMD)</u>

- 15.1. The Bidder shall furnish, as part of its bid, bid guarantee for an amount as specified in Section I Invitation for Bids under the clause of 'Tender Processing Fees and Earnest Money Deposit'. The bid guarantee shall be valid for a period of **210** days from the date of opening of bids.
- 15.2 In case of insufficient bid security for multiple locations, bid of the concerned bidder shall be taken into consideration chronologically from location 1 to downwards upto eligible location as per submitted EMD.
- 15.2. The EMD is required to protect the owner against the risk of Bidder's conduct, which would warrant the guarantee forfeiture, pursuant to Clause 15.7. The bid guarantee shall be made payable to the owner without any condition whatsoever.
- 15.3. The bid guarantee shall be denominated in Indian Rupees only and shall be paid in the forms as detailed in clause 4 of Section I- Invitation for Bids (IFB).
- 15.4. Any bid not secured in accordance with the above paragraphs will be rejected by the owner as non-responsive.
- 15.5. Unsuccessful Bidder's bid guarantee (EMD) will be discharged/returned within a period of one month from the date of execution of contract agreement with the successful bidder but not later than 60 days after the expiration of the period of bid validity prescribed by owner.



- 15.6. The successful Bidder's bid guarantee (EMD) will be refunded after submission of performance guarantee, as per tender terms and conditions.
- 15.7. The bid guarantee may be forfeited:
 - If a Bidder withdraws / modifies the bid during the period of bid validity specified by the Bidder on the Bid Form; or
 - In case of a successful Bidder, if the Bidder fails to sign the Contract; or
 - In case of a successful Bidder, if the Bidder fails to furnish the Performance Guarantee.
- 15.8. The EMD shall be submitted along with the bid through e-procurement portal. The bidder should pay the Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) in the e-Procurement portal using any of the following payment modes:
 - 1. Net Banking through payment gateway
 - 2. RTGS/ National Electronic Fund Transfer(NEFT)
 - 3. Bank Guarantee

- Any Bid without any Bid Security in accordance with provisions of this Clause will be rejected by the WBSEDCL and shall not be opened.
- In case of insufficient bid security for multiple locations, bid of the concerned bidder shall be taken into consideration chronologically from location 1 to downwards upto eligible location as per submitted EMD. Details calculation of EMD for single location to 111 nos location is attached (Annexure-C)

Hard copy of BG shall be submitted prior to the bid submission end date.



15.9. No interest shall be payable by WBSEDCL on the above EMD.

16. PERIOD OF VALIDITY OF BIDS

- 16.1. Bids shall remain valid for **180** days after the date of bid opening prescribed by the WBSEDCL unless otherwise specified in the Contract. A bid valid for a shorter period will be rejected as non-responsive.
- 16.2. In exceptional circumstances, owner may solicit the Bidder's consent for extension of the period of validity. The request and the response thereto shall be made in writing (including cable or telex or mail). The EMD provided under Clause 15 shall also be extended by the same period as the extension in the validity of the Bid. A Bidder may refuse the request without forfeiting his EMD. A Bidder granting the request will not be required or permitted to modify its bid.

17. TIME SCHEDULE

- 17.1. The basic consideration and the essence of the Contract is strict adherence to the Time Schedule in performing the specified Works.
- 17.2. The Owner's requirements of Completion Schedule for the Works are mentioned in the accompanying General Conditions of Contract. (Section GCC of the Bid Document). The Completion Schedule as stated in the Special Conditions of Contract shall be one of the major factors in consideration of the Bids.
- 17.3. The Owner reserves the right to request for a change in the Work Schedule during Pre Award discussions with successful Bidder.
- 17.4. The successful Bidder will be required to prepare detailed PERT Net Work (not Bar chart) and finalize the same with the Owner as per the requirement.

18. CONTRACT QUALITY ASSURANCE

- 18.1. The Bidder shall include in his proposal the Quality Assurance Program containing the overall Quality Management and Procedures which he proposes to follow in the Performance of the Works during various phases as detailed in relevant Clause of the General Technical Conditions.
- 18.2. At the time of Award of Contract, the detailed Quality Assurance Program to be followed for the execution of the Contract will be mutually discussed and agreed to and such agreed Program shall form a part of the Contract.



D. SUBMISSION OF BIDS

19. MODIFICATION AND WITHDRAWAL OF BIDS

- 19.1. The Bid shall be submitted in electronic form.

 The Techno- Commercial Bid consists of Techno Commercial Sheets
- 19.2. The Price Bid consists of Price Sheets
- 19.3. A prospective Bidder, who wishes to submit the Bid shall Technical-Commercial Bids, must include the Bid security submitted through any of the three e-payment modes mentioned in the e-procurement Portal.
- 19.4. Bidder shall key in the Prices and other details in Price Sheets and Techno-Commercial sheets and upload them on to the website on or before the time and date indicated in the Notification / Section IFB. Further no modification or withdrawal of Bid shall be allowed after the dead line.

20. DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION OF BIDS:

- 20.1. Bid shall be uploaded to the e-procurement portal on or before the last date and time for submission of Bids indicated in Notification in IFB.
- 20.2. The Owner may, at his discretion, extend this deadline for the submission of Bids by amending the Bidding Document, in which case all rights and obligations of the Owner and Bidders previously subject to the deadline will thereafter be subject to the deadline as extended.

21. LATE BIDS:

21.1. Any Bid uploaded by Bidder after the Time and Date fixed or extended for submission of Bids prescribed by the Owner, will be rejected and not considered for evaluation.

E. BID OPENING AND EVALUATION

22. OPENING OF BIDS & CHECKS

- 22.1. Opening of bids will be carried out as per the schedule notified in the E-procurement portal.
- 22.2. The Bidder's representatives who are present shall sign in a Bid opening register.
- 22.3. The Chief Engineer, Project III, WBSEDCL will examine the Bids to determine whether the Bidder satisfies all the eligibility criteria and/or whether required sureties have been furnished

And/or whether the documents have been properly signed and whether the Bids are generally in order.

- 22.4. The bids shall be examined to determine whether
 - 22.4.1. They are complete
 - 22.4.2. The bidder satisfies the eligibility criteria
 - 22.4.3. The required sureties have been furnished
 - 22.4.4. The documents have been properly signed
 - 22.4.5. The bids are generally in order.
- 22.5. Owner may waive any minor informality or non-conformity or irregularity in a bid which does not constitute a material deviation, provided such waiver does not prejudice or affect the relative ranking of any Bidder.

23. EVALUATION OF THE TENDERS

- 23.1 Bidder will be presented with list of sites. The list of sites is as mentioned in Annexure-1. The Successful Bidder would be selected through a competitive bidding process based on the essential minimum qualifying requirements (clause no: 11 of Section 1 IFB) and price bids.
- The financial offer of the bidder which is below Rs. 1.00/KWH will not be considered for evaluation and such bid shall be rejected.
- In the e-procurement portal, the bidder will have to bid a "Rs. per kWh" that will be shared with WBSEDCL.
- 23.4 The circular of West Bengal Government (Memorandum No: 2320-F(Y) dated 07.06.2022) shall be followed in case of tie (same rate quoted by two or more bidders).

24 CONTACTING THE OWNER

24.1 Bids shall be deemed to be under consideration immediately after they are opened and until such time official intimation of award/rejection is made by the owner to the Bidders. While the bids are under consideration, Bidders and/or their representatives or other interested parties are advised to refrain from contacting by any means, the owner and/or his employees/representatives on matters related to the bids under consideration. The Owner, if necessary, will obtain clarifications on the bids by requesting for such information from any or all the Bidders, either in writing or through personal contacts as may be necessary. Bidders will not be permitted to change the substance of the bids after the bids have been opened.

- 24.2 No Bidder shall contact the Owner on any matter relating to its Bid, from the time of the bid opening to the time the contract is awarded.
- 24.3 Any effort by a Bidder to influence the Owner in the Owner's bid evaluation, bid comparison or contract award decisions may result in disqualification.

F. AWARD OF CONTRACT

25 AWARD CRITERIA

25.1 WBSEDCL will award the Contract to the successful Bidder whose bid has been determined to be responsive and has been determined as the successful bid with highest price, provided further that the Bidder is determined to be qualified to perform the Contract satisfactorily. WBSEDCL shall be the sole judge in this regard.

Note: The successful bidder shall be entirely responsible for payment of all taxes, levies, duties, license fees, insurance etc., incurred until delivery of the contracted goods to the site. In respect of carrying out works, the successful bidder shall pay all types of fees, levies, taxes, duties, insurance etc. required to be paid by any National or State statute, ordinance or other law or any regulation or bye-law of any local or other duly constituted authority in relation to the execution of works and by the Rules and Regulations of all Public bodies and companies whose property or rights are affected or may be affected in any way of the works. The successful bidder shall in compliance with the above keep the WBSEDCL indemnified against all such penalties and liability of every kind for breach of any statute, ordinance or law, Regulation or bye-law. Nothing in the contract shall relieve the successful bidder from his responsibility to pay any tax that may be levied by the Government on the turnover / profits etc., made by him in respect of the contract.

25.2 Notwithstanding the above, if it is found that the performance vis – a - vis works awarded to the Bidder by WBSEDCL is either behind schedule or not satisfactory, WBSEDCL will be at liberty to disqualify the Bidder and reject its Bid at any stage of processing of the Bid.

26 RIGHT TO ACCEPT ANY BID AND TO REJECT ANY OR ALL BIDS

26.1 The Owner reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, and to annul the bidding process and reject all bids at any time prior to award of the Contract, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected Bidder or Bidders or any obligation to inform the affected Bidder or Bidders of the grounds for the owner's action.

27 NOTIFICATION OF AWARD

27.1 Acceptance of work rates by the Purchaser will be communicated in writing by registered letter or by e-mail. In case the acceptance is communicated in writing by registered letter or by e-mail, the formal work order will be forwarded to the supplier as soon as possible and the instructions contained in the acceptance letter should be acted upon immediately. Posting of L.O.I. even on the last day of validity of offer shall be binding upon the bidder.

- 27.2 The notification of the award will constitute the formation of the Contract.
- 27.3 Upon the successful Bidder's furnishing of Contract Performance Guarantee, the owner will notify each unsuccessful Bidder and will discharge their EMD.

28 SIGNING OF CONTRACT

- 28.1 Once the LoA is issued and its acknowledgement is received, it shall be ensured by the bidder that formal Contract Agreement, appending therewith all the documents forming part of the Contract, is signed between WBSEDCL and the Contractor in two original copies, within 28 days from date of receipt of LoA as per Annexure-E in the Bidding Documents.
- 28.2 At the same time, as the owner notifies the successful Bidder that their bid has been accepted, the owner will send the Bidder the detailed Letter of Award, incorporating all agreements between the parties.

29 CONTRACT PERFORMANCE GUARANTEE

29.1 The successful bidder shall have to deposit performance security of Rs. 54,750.00 (Rupees Fifty four thousand seven hundred fifty) per location for the performance of the contract in the form of BG from a Scheduled Bank (Annexure F). The guarantee shall be valid up to a period of 90 days after the expiry of overall engagement period. The Performance guarantee shall be submitted within fifteen days (15 days) or before signing of contract agreement whichever is earlier from the date of issuance of LoA.

The performance security of a Joint Venture (JV) shall be in the name of the Joint Venture (JV) specifying the names of all members.

General Terms & Conditions of Contract (GCC)

A. INTRODUCTION

1. **DEFINITION OF TERMS**

- 1.1. 'Contract' means the agreement entered between the Owner and the Contractor as per the Contract Agreement signed by the parties, including all attachments and appendices thereto and all documents incorporated by reference therein.
- 1.2. 'Owner' shall mean West Bengal State Electricity Distribution Company Limited, (WBSEDCL) and shall include its legal representatives, successors and assigns.
- 1.3. 'Contractor' or 'Manufacturer' or 'Selected Bidder' or 'Bidder' or 'Successful Bidder' shall mean the Bidder whose bid will be accepted by the Owner for the award of the Works and shall include such successful Bidder's legal representatives, successors and permitted assigns.
- 1.4. 'Engineer' shall mean the Chief Engineer, Dist Project-III, WBSEDCL or the Divisional Manager of the division or the officer appointed by WBSEDCL to act as Engineer from time to time for the purpose of the Contract.
- 1.5. 'Consulting Engineer'/'Consultant' shall mean any firm or person duly appointed as such from time to time by the Owner.
- 1.6. The terms 'Equipment', 'Stores' and 'Materials' shall mean and include equipment, stores and materials to be provided by the Contractor under the Contract.
- 1.7. 'Works' shall mean and include all the activities to be carried out as per the detailed scope of the work.
- 1.8. "Specifications" shall mean the Specifications and Bidding Document forming a part of the Contract and such other schedules and drawings as may be mutually agreed upon
- 1.9. The term 'Contract price' shall mean the price quoted by the Contractor in his bid with additions and/or deletions as may be agreed and incorporated in the Letter of Award, for the entire scope of the works.
- 1.10. 'Inspector' shall mean the Owner or any person nominated by the Owner from time to time, to inspect the equipment; stores or Works under the Contract and/or the duly authorized representative of the Owner.
- 1.11. 'Site' shall mean and include the Land and other places on, into or through which the Works and the related facilities are to be Erected .
- 1.12. 'Notice of Award of Contract'/'Letter of Award' shall mean the official notice issued by the Owner notifying the Contractor that his bid has been accepted.
- 1.13. 'Date of Contract' shall mean the date on which Notice of Award of Contract/Letter of



Award has been issued.

- 1.14. 'Month' shall mean the calendar month. 'Day' or 'Days' unless herein otherwise expressly defined shall mean calendar day or days of 24 hours each.
 - A 'Week' shall mean continuous period of seven (7) days.
- 1.15. 'Writing' shall include any manuscript, type written or printed statement, with signature and/or seal as the case may be.
- 1.16. Test on completion shall mean such tests as prescribed in the Contract to be performed by the Contractor before the work is taken over by the Owner.
- 1.17. "Startup" shall mean the time period required to bring the equipment covered under the Contract from an inactive condition, when construction is essentially complete, to the state ready for trial operation. The start-up period shall include preliminary inspection and check-out of equipment and supporting sub-system, initial operation of the complete equipment covered under the Contract to obtain necessary pre-trial operation data, perform calibration and corrective action, shut- down, inspection and adjustment prior to the trial operation period
- 1.18. "Performance and Guarantee Tests", shall mean all operational checks and tests required to determine and demonstrate capacity, efficiency, and operating characteristics as specified in the Contract Documents.
- 1.19. The term "Final Acceptance"/ "Taking Over" shall mean the Owner's written acceptance of the Works performed under the Contract, after successful commissioning/completion of Performance and Guarantee Tests, as specified in the accompanying Technical Specifications or otherwise agreed in the Contract
- 1.20. 'Commercial Operation' shall mean the condition of operation in which the complete equipment covered under the Contract is officially declared by the Owner to be available for continuous operation at different loads up to and including rated capacity. Such declaration by the Owner, however, shall not relieve or absolve the Contractor of any of his obligations under the Contract.
- 1.21. 'Guarantee Period' shall mean the period during which the Contractor shall remain liable for repair or replacement of any defective part of the works performed under the Contract
- 1.22. 'Engineer in charge of work' shall mean the Divisional Manager of the respective Division awarded.
- 1.23. 'Latent Defects' shall mean such defects caused by faulty material or work-man-ship which cannot be detected during inspection, testing etc, based on the technology available for carrying out such tests.
- 1.24. 'Plans, shall mean all:
- 1.24.1. Drawings furnished by the Owner/Consultant as a basis of Bid/Proposals.
- 1.24.2. Supplementary drawings furnished by the Owner/Consultant to clarify and to define in **5** | P a g e WBSEDCL / EV CHARGING STATION



greater detail the intent of the Contract.

- 1.24.3. Drawings submitted by the Contractor with his bid provided such drawings are acceptable to the Owner/Consultant
- 1.24.4. Plans submitted by the Contractor for executing the works with his bid provided such plans are acceptable to the Owner/Consultant.
- 1.24.5. Engineering data and drawings submitted by the Contractor as per designs during the progress of the work provided such drawings are acceptable to the Engineer/Owner.
- 1.25. Words imparting the singular only shall also include the plural and vice versa where the context so requires.
- 1.26. Words imparting 'Person' shall include firms, companies, corporations and associations or bodies of individuals, whether incorporated or not.
- 1.27. Terms and expressions not herein defined shall have the same meaning as are assigned to them in the Indian Sale of Goods Act 1930, failing that in the Indian Contract Act 1872 and failing that in the General Clauses Act 1897 including amendments thereof, if any.
- 1.28. Commissioning: Under this contract shall mean Charging the vehicle after Completion of Erection, Testing and Completion of Pre-Commissioning checks after necessary approvals from Electrical Inspectorate (if applicable).
- 1.29. In addition to the above the following definitions shall also apply:
 - a) 'All equipment and materials' to be supplied shall also mean 'Goods'.
 - b) 'Constructed' shall also mean 'erected and installed'.
 - c) 'Contract Performance Guarantee' shall also mean 'Contract Performance Security'.

2. APPLICATION

2.1. These General Conditions shall apply to the extent that they are not superseded by provisions in other parts of the Contract.

3. **STANDARDS**

3.1. The EV Charging Station under this Contract shall conform to the standards mentioned in the Guidelines i.r.o. Charging Infrastructure for Electric Vehicle (EV) issued vide Circular No. 12/2/2018-EV(com No.244347) dated 14th January 2022 by Ministry of power, Govt of India.



4. LANGUAGE AND MEASURES

4.1. All documents pertaining to the Contract including specifications, schedules, notices, correspondences, operating and maintenance instructions, drawings or any other writing shall be written in English language. The Metric System of measurement shall be used exclusively in the Contract.

5. **CONTRACT DOCUMENTS**

- 5.1. The term Contract Documents shall mean and include the following, which shall be deemed to form an integral part of the Contract:
 - Invitation to Bid including letter forwarding the Bidding Documents, Instructions to Bidders, General Terms and Conditions of Contract and all other documents included under Volume- I.
 - b) Contractor's Bid Proposal and the documents attached there to including the letters of clarifications thereto between the Contractor and the Owner/Consultant prior to the Award of Contract except to the extent of repugnancy.
 - c) All the materials, literature, data and information of any sort given by the Contractor along with his bid, subject to the approval of the Owner /Consultant.
 - d) Letter of Award and any agreed variations of the conditions of the documents, if any.
- 5.2. In the event of any conflict between the above mentioned documents, the matter shall be referred to the Chief Engineer, Dist Project-III whose decision shall be considered as final and binding upon the parties.
- 5.3. All the relevant Information furnished by the Contractor such as Specifications of Material/ Equipment, Design, Literature, Drawings or any other Data during the course of Contract will become the Property of the Owner and Owner will have full rights to use the same elsewhere. After expiry of contract period, equipment(s) / chargers will be dismantled and taken back to their custody.

6. USE OF CONTRACT DOCUMENTS AND INFORMATION

- 6.1. The Contractor shall not, without the Owner's prior written consent, disclose the Contract, or any provision thereof, or any specification, plan, drawing, pattern, sample or information furnished by or on behalf of the Owner in connection therewith, to any person other than a person employed by the Contractor in the performance of the Contract. Disclosure to any such employed person shall be made in confidence and shall extend only as far as may be necessary for the purpose of such performance.
- 6.2. The Contractor shall not, without the Owner's prior written consent, make use of any document or information enumerated in various Contract documents except for the purpose of performing the Contract.
- 6.3. The Contractor shall not communicate or use in advertising, publicity, sales releases or in any other medium, photographs or other reproduction of the Works under this Contract,



or descriptions of the site, dimensions, quantity, quality or other information, concerning the works unless prior written permission has been obtained from the Owner.

6.4. Any document, other than the Contract itself, enumerated in various Contract documents shall remain the property of the Owner and shall be returned (in all copies) to the Owner on completion of the Contractor's performance under the Contract if so required by the Owner.

7. CONSTRUCTION OF THE CONTRACT

- 7.1. Notwithstanding anything stated elsewhere in the bid documents, the Contract to be entered into will be treated as a single contract for installing, commissioning and operating EV Charging Stations as detailed in the scope of works.
- 7.2. The Contract shall in all respects be construed and governed according to Indian Laws.

8. <u>AMENDMENT</u>

8.1. No amendment or other variation of the contract shall be effective unless it is in writing, is dated, expressly refers to the contract, and is signed by a duly authorized representative of each party hereto.

9. JURISDICTION OF THE CONTRACT

9.1. The laws applicable to the Contract shall be the laws in force in India. The Courts in Kolkata, West Bengal shall have exclusive jurisdiction in all matters arising under this Contract.

10. MANNER OF EXECUTION OF THE CONTRACT

- 10.1. The Owner, after the issue of the Letter of Award to the Contractor, will send one copy of the final Contract Agreement to the Contractor for his scrutiny and approval.
- 10.2. The Agreement, unless otherwise agreed to, shall be signed within 15 days of the Letter of Award between WBSEDCL and successful bidder, at the office of the Owner on a date and time to be mutually agreed. The Contractor shall provide for signing of the Contract, Performance Bank Guarantee in four copies, appropriate power of attorney and other requisite materials at the office of Chief Engineer, Dist Project-III, 2nd floor, C Block, Bidyut Bhavan, WBSEDCL. In case the Contract is to be signed beyond the stipulated time, the Bid Guarantee submitted with the Proposal will have to be extended accordingly.
- 10.3. The Agreement will be signed in 2 (two) originals and the Contractor shall be provided with one signed original and the other will be retained by the WBSEDCL.
- 10.4. Subsequent to signing of the Contract Agreement, Concession Agreements shall be executed between the Lead Bidder and the Authorized Representative of WBSEDCL for executing work and operating EV Charging Stations over the engagement period.



10.5. Subsequent to signing of the Concession Agreement, the Contractor at his own Cost shall provide the Owner with at least 10 (ten) true Bounded Copies of Contract documents within thirty (30) days after the signing of the Contract.

11. ENFORCEMENT OF TERMS

11.1. The failure of either party to enforce at any time any of the provisions of this Contract or any rights in respect thereto or to exercise any option therein provided, shall in no way be construed to be a waiver of such provisions, rights or options or in any way to affect

the validity of the Contract. The exercise by either party of any of its rights herein shall not preclude or prejudice either party from exercising the same or any other right it may have under the Contract.

12. COMPLETION OF THE CONTRACT

12.1. Unless otherwise terminated under the provisions of any other relevant clause, the contractual (Engagement) period from date of hand over of site shall be 120 months (execution period is included within engagement period).

B. GUARANTEES & LIABILITIES

13. TIME – THE ESSENCE OF THE CONTRACT

- 13.1. The timelines for Commissioning of Electric Vehicle Charging Stations (EVCS) as detailed in the scope of the works and so incorporated in the Letter of Award, shall be deemed to be the essence of the Contract. The Contractor shall so organize his resources and perform his work as to complete the work in stipulated timelines.
- 13.2. The Contractor shall submit a detailed PERT Network Chart, within the time frame agreed, consisting of adequate number of activities covering various key Phases of the Work such as Design, Procurement, Manufacturing, Shipment, Receiving of the Owner Supplied Equipment (if any), and Field Erection activities within fifteen (15) days of the date of Letter of Award. This Network shall also indicate the Interface facilities to be provided by the Owner and the dates by which such facilities are needed. The Contractor shall discuss the Network so submitted with the Owner and the agreed Network shall form part of the Contract Documents. During the Performance of the Contract, if in the opinion of the Engineer, proper progress is not maintained; Suitable changes shall be made in the Contractor's Operations to ensure proper progress without any Cost implication to the Owner. The Interface Facilities to be provided by the Owner in accordance with the agreed Network shall also be reviewed while reviewing the progress of the Contract. The PERT Network should be reviewed, updated, once every Month and submitted to Engineer for approval.
- 13.3. Based on the above-agreed Network Chart, weekly reports shall be submitted by the Contractor as directed by the Engineer.



- 13.4. Subsequent to the, finalization of the Network, the Contractor shall make available to the Engineer a detailed delivery schedule of equipments, in line with the agreed Contract Network. Such schedule shall be reviewed, updated and submitted to the Engineer once every two weeks thereafter.
- 13.5. The contractor shall submit location-wise estimated EVSEs breakup to Chief Engineer, Dist Project-III, C Block, 2nd floor, Bidyut Bhavan within 30 days from the letter of Award.
- 13.6. The successful bidder shall complete the work of Commissioning of EVCS as detailed in the scope of the work within 6 months of the date of handing over of site. However consequent to delay in execution of works attributable to the Owner, the Bidder shall not be held responsible for the same.
- 13.7. The reporting/verifying/approving authority may suggest changes in the proposed plans which shall be incorporated by the Selected Bidder.
- 13.8. The Selected Bidder shall also submit monthly compliance reports with details of number of EVSEs provided each location.
- 13.9. The Selected Bidder shall submit the progress reports for number of EVSE installed and commissioned on weekly basis.
- 13.10. The formats for reporting compliance of number of EVSE installed and commissioned shall be as decided by Chief Engineer, Dist Project-III, C Block, 2nd floor, Bidyut Bhavan .

14. <u>Installation</u>

14.1 Contractor's Supervision

The Contractor shall give or provide all necessary supervision during the installation of the Facilities, and the site supervisor shall be constantly on the Site to provide full-time supervision of the installation. The Contractor shall provide only personnel who are skilled and experienced in their respective field.

14.2 Labour

- a. The Contractor shall provide and employ on the Site in the installation of the Facilities such skilled, semi-skilled and unskilled labour as is necessary for the proper and timely execution of the Contract. The Contractor is bound to abide by the Labour Laws enforced by Govt of West Bengal/Govt of India.
- b. Unless otherwise provided in the Contract, the Contractor at its own expense shall be responsible for the recruitment, transportation, accommodation and catering of all labour, local or expatriate, required for the execution of the Contract and for all payments in connection therewith.
- c. The Contractor shall at all times during the progress of the Contract use its best endeavours to prevent any unlawful, riotous or disorderly conduct or behavior by or amongst its employees and the labour of its Subcontractors.



d. The Contractor shall, in all dealings with its labour and others connected with the Contract, pay due regard to all recognized festivals, official holidays, religious or other customs and all local laws and regulations pertaining to the employment of labour.

14.3 Site Regulations and Safety

- 14.3.1The Employer and the Contractor shall establish Site regulations setting out the rules to be observed in the execution of the Contract at the Site and shall comply therewith. The Contractor shall prepare & submit to Employer, the proposed Site regulations for Employer's approval, which approval shall not be unreasonably withheld.
- 14.3.2Such Site regulations shall include, but shall not be limited to, rules in respect of security, safety of the Facilities, gate control, sanitation, medical care, and fire prevention.

14.4 Compliance with Labour Regulations

- 14.4.1During continuance of the contract, the Contractor and his sub-contractors shall abide at all times by all applicable existing labour enactments and rules made there under, regulations notifications and byelaws of the State or Central Government or local authority and any other labour law (including rules), regulations bye laws that may be passed or notification that may be issued under any labour law in future either by the State or the Central Government or the local authority. The employees of the Contractor and the Sub-contractor in no case shall be treated as the employees of the Employer at any point of time.
- **14.4.2**The Contractor shall keep the owner indemnified in case any action is taken against the owner by the competent authority on account of contravention of any of the provisions of any Act or rules made there under, regulations or notifications including amendments.
- 14.4.3If the owner is caused to pay under any law as principal employer such amounts as may be necessary to cause or observe, or for nonobservance of the provisions stipulated in the notifications/ byelaws/Acts/ Rules/regulations including amendments, if any, on the part of the Contractor, the owner shall have the right to deduct any money due to the Contractor under this contract or any other contract with the owner including his amount of performance security for adjusting the aforesaid payment. The owner shall also have right to recover from the Contractor any sum required or estimated to be required for making good the loss or damage suffered by the owner. Notwithstanding the above, the Contractor shall furnish to the owner the details/documents evidencing the Contractor's compliance to the laws applicable to establishments engaged in building and other construction works, as may be sought by the owner. In particular the Contractor shall submit quarterly certificate regarding compliance in respect of provisions of Employees Provident Fund and Misc. Provisions Act 1952 to the owner.

14.5 Site Clearance

14.5.1Site Clearance in Course of Performance

In the course of carrying out the Contract, the Contractor shall keep the Site reasonably free from all unnecessary obstruction, store or remove any surplus materials, clear away any wreckage, rubbish or temporary works from the Site, and remove any Contractor's Equipment no longer required for execution of the Contract.



14.5.2Clearance of Site after Completion

After Completion of all parts of the Facilities, the Contractor shall clear away and remove all wreckage, rubbish and debris of any kind from the Site, and shall leave the Site and Facilities clean and safe.

14.6 Watching and Lighting

14.6.1The Contractor shall provide and maintain at its own expense all lighting, fencing, and watching when and where necessary for the proper execution and the protection of the Facilities, or for the safety of the owners and occupiers of adjacent property and for the safety of the public

15 EFFECTIVENESS OF THE CONTRACT

15.1 The Contract shall be considered as having come into force from the date of the notification of award unless otherwise provided in the notification of award.

16 TAXES, PERMITS & LICENCES

- 16.1 The Contractor shall be liable and pay all non-Indian taxes, duties, levies lawfully assessed against the Owner or the Contractor in pursuance of the Contract. In addition the Contractor shall be responsible for payment of all Indian duties, levies and taxes lawfully assessed against the Contractor for his personal income & property only.
- 16.2 No claim for any increase towards the Statutory Variation regarding enhancement of existing Tax or Duty or introduction of a new Tax or Duty applicable shall be entertained by the owner during the extended period of contract, if any, if extension of the Contract is required due to the causes attributable to the Contractor.
- 16.3 The Owner will deduct Taxes applicable at Source as per applicable law from the proceeds payable to the Contractor.

17 PATENT RIGHTS AND ROYALTIES

17.1 Royalties and fees for patents covering materials, articles, apparatus, devices, equipment or processes used in the works shall be deemed to have been included in the Contract Price. The Contractor shall satisfy all demands that may be made at any time for such royalties or fees and he alone shall be liable for any damages or claims for patent infringements and shall keep the Owner indemnified in that regard. The Contractor shall, at his own cost and expense, defend all suits or proceedings that may be instituted for alleged infringement of any patents involved in the Works, and, in case of an award of damages, the Contractor shall pay for such award. In the event of any suit or other proceedings instituted against the Owner, the same shall be defended at the cost and expense of the Contractor who shall also satisfy/comply with any decree, order or award made against the Owner. But it shall be understood that no such machine, plant, work, material or thing has been used by the Owner for any purpose or any manner other than



that for which they have been furnished and installed by the Contractor and specified under these specifications. Final payment to the Contractor by the Owner will not be made while any such suit or claim remains unsettled. In the event any apparatus or equipment, or any part thereof furnished by the Contractor, is in such suit or proceedings held to constitute infringement, and its use is enjoined, the Contractor shall at his option and at his own expense, either procure for the Owner, the right to continue the use of said apparatus, equipment or part thereof, replace it with non-infringing apparatus or equipment or modify it, so it becomes non-infringing.

18 DEFENCE OF SUITS

18.1 If any action before any court of law is brought against the Owner or Engineer or an officer or agent of the Owner, for the failure, omission or neglect on the part of the Contractor to perform any acts, matters, covenants or things under the Contract, or for damage or injury caused by the alleged omission or negligence on the part of the Contractor, his agents, representatives or his Sub-Contractors, or in connection with any claim based on lawful demands of Sub-Contractors, workmen, suppliers or employees, the Contractor shall in all such cases indemnify and keep the Owner, and the Engineer and/or his representative, indemnified harmless from all losses, damages, expenses or decrees arising of such action.

19 LIMITATION OF LIABILITIES

- 19.1 The Bidder shall be liable to WBSEDCL for loss or damage occurred or caused or likely to occur on account of any act of omission on the part of the Bidder and its employees, including loss caused to WBSEDCL on account of deficiency in Services or any other Deliverables on the part of Bidder or its agents or any person / persons claiming through or under said System Integrator. However, such liability of Bidder under this Agreement shall not exceed 100% of the Total Value of the Performance Security.
- 19.2 Except as otherwise provided herein, in no event shall either Party be liable for any consequential, incidental, indirect, special or punitive damage, loss or expenses (including but not limited to business interruption, lost business, lost profits, lost savings, death, IP infringement) nor for any third party claims, even if it has been advised of their possible existence.
- 19.3 This limitation of liability provided in this Clause shall not limit the Bidders liability for the indemnity obligations as agreed in this Agreement.
- 19.4 The final payment by the Owner by releasing the Contract performance Guarantee in pursuance of the Contract shall mean the release of the Contractor from all his liabilities under the Contract. Such final payment shall be made only at the end of the contract period, and till such time as the Contractual liabilities and responsibilities of the Contractor, shall prevail. All other payments made under the Contract shall be treated as on-account payments.



20 ENGINEER'S DECISION

- 20.1 In respect of all matters which are left to the decision of the Engineer including the granting or with-holding of the certificates, the Engineer shall, if required to do so by the Contractor, give in writing a decision thereon.
- 20.2 If, in the opinion of the Contractor, a decision made by the Engineer is not in accordance with the meaning and intent of the Contract, the Contractor may file with the Engineer, within fifteen (15) days after receipt of the decision, a written objection to the decision. Failure to file an objection within the allotted time will be considered as an acceptance of the Engineer's decision and the decision shall become final and binding.
- 20.3 It is the intent of the Agreement that there shall be no delay in the execution of the works and the decision of the Engineer as rendered shall be promptly observed.

21 ASSIGNMENT OF CONTRACT

21.1 The details of EV Charging equipment vendors along with details of specification of equipment under consideration by the Contractor for this Contract shall be furnished to the ordering authority for information prior to procurement. Copy of purchase order shall be provided by the contractor to the ordering authority. Such information shall not relieve the Contractor of any obligation, duty or responsibility under the Contract. Any assignment as above, without prior written information to the ordering authority, shall be void.

22 NO WAIVER OF RIGHTS

22.1 Neither the inspection by the Owner or the Engineer or any of their officials, employees, or agents nor any order by the Owner or the Engineer for payment of money or any payment for or acceptance of, the whole or any part of the Works by the Owner or the Engineer, nor any extension of time, nor any possession taken by the Engineer shall operate as a waiver of any provision of the Contract, or of any power herein reserved to the Owner or any right to damages herein provided nor shall any waiver of any breach in the Contract be held to be a waiver of any other or subsequent breach.

23 PROGRESS REPORTS AND PHOTOGRAPHS

During the various stages of the work in pursuance of the Contract, the Contractor shall at his own cost submit periodic progress reports as may be reasonably required by the Engineer and detailed in the scope of works with photographs etc. or as may be required by the Engineer.



24 PAYMENTS

- 24.1 The revenue sharing shall be done between WBSEDCL and the Concessionaire / bidder. As per the provisions of agreement all the disputes regarding land related matters shall be resolved mutually between WBSEDCL and the Concessionaire/bidder.
- 24.2 The payment shall be made by Concessionaire to WBSEDCL through ESCROW mechanism at a fixed rate (as discovered in the tender) recorded in the CMS through the charging stations.
- 24.3 The CMS dashboard access shall be provided to WBSEDCL for verifying the monthly revenue out of the charging.
- 24.4 The revenue generated from the EV Charging Stations will be deposited in an ESCROW

account and will be shared between Concessionaire and WBSEDCL in mutually agreed ratio i.e., WBSEDCL shall get the revenue as discovered in the tender.

- **24.5** Action against any non-payment of dues by the concessionaire to WBSEDCL, shall include but is not limited to encashing the performance security submitted by the concessionaire.
- **24.6 Currency of Payment:** All payments under the Contract shall be in **Indian National Rupees** only.

25 PENALTY FOR DELAY IN EXECUTION/NON- EXECUTION OF THE WORK.

For delay in not taking up the works as planned and not completing the erection of the EVSE, a penalty as per SLA in Sec-IV, Special Conditions of Contract will be levied against the works of those EV Charging Stations.

26 <u>DEDUCTIONS FROM CONTRACT PRICE</u>

All costs, damages or expenses which the Owner may have paid, for which under the Contract the Contractor is liable, will be claimed by the Owner. All such claims shall be billed by the Owner to the Contractor regularly as and when they fall due. Such bills shall be supported by appropriate and certified vouchers or explanations, to enable the Contractor to properly identify such claims. Such claims shall be paid by the Contractor within thirty (30) days of the receipt of the corresponding bills and if not paid by the Contractor within the said period, the Owner may then deduct the amount, from performance security or may be recovered by application of Law or otherwise.

C. RISK DISTRIBUTION

27 **INSURANCE**

27.1 The Contractor at his cost shall arrange, secure and maintain all insurance as may be pertinent to the Works and obligatory in terms of law to protect his interest and interests of the Owner against all perils. The form and the limit of such insurance as defined



herein together with the under-writer in each case shall be acceptable to the Owner. However, irrespective of such acceptance, the responsibility to maintain adequate insurance coverage at all time during the period of Contract shall be of Contractor alone. The Contractor's failure in this regard shall not relieve him of any of his contractual responsibilities and obligations.

- 27.2 Any loss or damage to the equipment during handling, transportation, storage, erection, putting into satisfactory operation and all activities to be performed till the successful completion of commissioning of the equipment shall be to the account of the Contractor. The Contractor shall be responsible for preference of all claims and make good the damages or loss by way of repairs and/or replacement of the equipment, damaged or lost. The transfer of title shall not in any way relieve the Contractor of the above responsibilities during the period of Contract. The Contractor shall provide the Owner with copy of all insurance policies and documents taken out by him in pursuance of the Contract. Such copies of documents shall be submitted to the Owner immediately after such insurance coverage. The Contractor shall also inform the Owner in writing at least sixty (60) days in advance regarding the expiry/cancellation and/or change in any of such documents and ensure revalidation, renewal etc., as may be necessary well in time.
- 27.3 The perils required to be covered under the insurance shall include, but not be limited to fire and allied risks, miscellaneous accidents (erection risks) workman compensation risks, loss or damage in transit, theft, pilferage, riot and strikes and malicious damages, civil commotion, weather conditions, accidents of all kinds, etc. The scope of such insurance shall be adequate to cover the cost of erection of transformer centre as per new design inclusive of supply of materials, erection at site and inspectorate charges. The insurance policies to be taken should be on cost of transformer center as per new design incorporating escalation clause. Notwithstanding the extent of insurance cover and the amount of claim available from the underwriters, the Contractor shall be liable to make good the full replacement/rectification value of all equipment/materials and to ensure their availability as per project requirements.
- 27.4 All costs on account of insurance liabilities covered under the Contract will be on Contractor's account and will be included in Contract Price,

28 LIABILITY FOR ACCIDENTS AND DAMAGES

Under the Contract, the Contractor shall be responsible for loss or accidents which might arise owing to non – observation of safety requirements or else wise by its staff during erection of the EVSEs and associated accessories. Also the contractor shall be responsible for loss or damage to the plant until successful completion of commissioning as defined elsewhere in the Bid document.

29 <u>DEMURRAGE, WHARFAGE, ETC.</u>

All demurrage, wharfage, and other expenses incurred due to delayed clearance of the Material or any other reason shall be to the account of the Contractor.



30 FIRST AID

To deal with emergency/accidental eventualities at works site, the Contractor shall make all such arrangements necessary, such as services of an ambulance etc. for transportation to hospital at his own cost.

31 FORCE MAJEURE

- 31.1 Force majeure is herein defined as any cause which is beyond the control of the Contractor or the Owner as the case may be, which they could not foresee or despite reasonable amount of diligence could not have foreseen and which substantially affects the performance of the Contract, such as:
 - a. Natural phenomena, including but not limited to floods, droughts, earthquakes and epidemics;
 - b. Acts of any Government, domestic or foreign, including but not limited to war, declared or undeclared, priorities, guarantees, and embargoes.

Provided either party shall within fifteen (15) days from the occurrence of such a cause notify the other in writing of such causes.

- 31.1 The Contractor or the Owner shall not be liable for delays in performing his obligations resulting from any force majeure cause as referred to and/or defined above
- 31.2 The date of completion will, subject to hereinafter provided, be extended by a reasonable time even though such cause may occur after Contractor's performance of obligation has been delayed due to other causes.

32 CONTRACTOR'S DEFAULT/LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

In case of any delay in the execution of the order beyond the stipulated date including any extension permitted in writing, WBSEDCL reserves right to recover from the Contractor a penalty at the rate of INR 5,000 per site for every one week's delay or any part thereof, subjected to a maximum of INR 50,000/-. The amount of penalty can be recovered from any amount including performance security.

33 TERMINATION OF CONTRACT

33.1 WBSEDCL can terminate the contract in case of insufficient performance security/non compliance of service level Agreement. If such case arises, 30 days prior notice shall be issued before termination of the contract.



- 33.2 The owner/agency may apply for terminating the contract by serving 3(three) months notice in writing after 02(two) years from the date of commercial operation of the site and in such event of termination of termination of contract the performance security shall be refunded to the bidder. If the agency request for discontinuation of the contract before 02(two) years from the date of commercial operation of site and contract is terminated then Performance security shall not be refunded.
- 33.3 Pursuant to clause above, Concessionaire shall remove the Charging Units and other infrastructure (created by Concessionaire) at its own cost.
- 33.4 The activities pursuant to the Exit Management will be completed within 30 days' from the date of issue of notice. However, Parties may mutually increase or decrease the execution period based on real time requirements.

D. RESOLUTION OF DISPUTES

34 <u>SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES</u>

- 34.1 Any dispute(s) or difference(s) arising out of or in connection with the Contract shall, to the extent possible, be settled amicably between the parties.
- 34.2 If any dispute or difference of any kind, whatsoever, shall arise between the Owner and the Contractor, arising out of the Contract for the performance of the Works whether during the progress of the Works or after its completion or whether before or after the termination, abandonment or breach of the Contract, it shall, be referred to and settled by the AGM(HR&A), Distribution Project-III, Block C,2nd floor, Bidyut Bhavan who, within a period of thirty (30) days after being requested by either party to do so, shall give written notice of his decision to the Owner and the Contractor.
- 34.3 All the differences or disputes arising out of the contract/agreement if any further shall be decided by a competent Court at Kolkata in the event the decision of the AGM(HR&A), Distribution Project-III, WBSEDCL appears to be unsatisfactory to the contractor, at its instance.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT (SCC)

1 Background

Power Department, Government of West Bengal issued Electric Vehicle Policy 2021 (No: 189-POW-2021 date: 3rd June'2021) in which state will target to be the best state in electric mobility penetration by 2030 and target to have 10 lakh EVs, combined across all segment of vehicles, during the policy implementation. WBSEDCL has been designated as the "State Nodal Agency" for setting up Charging Infrastructure for Electric Vehicle vide notification no. 51-PO/O/C-III/4M-27/2017 Dated 12.03.2019. By this time, with due approval of WBERC, specific Tariff for EV Charging station's service connection has also been issued by CE, Regulation, WBSEDCL. The gist of tariff order dated 22.07.2022 for the year 2022-23 is available in www.wbsedcl.in. Because of the vast infrastructure needed to charge electric vehicles (EVs), utilities hold the keys to accelerating their deployment. By accelerating EV deployment, utilities can increase energy demand and revenue growth. Charging infrastructure will play a pivotal role on EV deployment, and, in the absence of a proactive plan and schedule, is a major impediment to mass market adoption. Infrastructure limitations are particularly pertinent to EVs due to their sole dependency on electricity. The charging infrastructure includes all of the hardware and software that ensures energy is transferred from the electric grid to the vehicle. Charging locations combined with an acceptable charging time strategy encourages better use of Electric Vehicles by general public in West Bengal. WBSEDCL is seeking proposals from interested agencies for "Supply, Installation, Operation

WBSEDCL is seeking proposals from interested agencies for "Supply, Installation, Operation and Management of Electric Vehicle Charging Station/ Battery Swapping station at "WBSEDCL's own land".

2 <u>Definitions</u>

- 2.1. **Bidder:** Entity which is eligible to bid for the concessional locations in this tender as per the eligibility criteria laid down this RFP.
- 2.2. **Concessionaire**: Entity which has won the bid for operating and maintaining PCS for the concessional locations under this NIT for the engagement period as mentioned in Section.
- 2.3. **Electric Vehicle Supply Equipment (EVSE)**: Element in EV charging infrastructure that supplies electric energy for recharging the battery of electric vehicles.
- 2.4. **Public Charging Stations (PCS)**: Consists of EVSE, associated electrical infrastructure, space for parking (with clearance), ingress/egress for vehicles and has open (unrestricted) access for the public. Additionally, PCS must not have any usage restriction for any EV user. For instance, PCS usage cannot be restricted by providing services only on a subscription basis.
- 2.5. **Battery Swapping Facility (BSF)**: A station where a discharged or partially charged battery of an EV can be swapped for a fully charged battery.
 - 2.6. **Slow Charger/Moderate/Fast Charger**: For the purpose of this tender, a moderate / fast charger as defined in the revised consolidated Guidelines and Stands issued dated 14th January, 2022 or updated in later on.



- 2.7. Downtime: refers to the time duration when EV charger is non-operational due to disruption in power supply or disruption in IT service (server-side error) or both. In this context, the downtime due to disruption in power supply from the WBSEDCL will not be accounted for penalty. Therefore, here "Downtime" is accounted due to disruption in IT service or faulty equipment. Downtime is measured based on server-side error rate.
- 2.8. **Monthly Uptime Percentage**: means the total number of minutes in a calendar month minus the number of minutes of Downtime suffered in a calendar month, divided by the total number of minutes in a calendar month.
- 2.9. **Electricity Tariff**: Refers to the cost of energy charges including tariff associated charges viz. regulatory surcharges, electricity duty, fuel adjustment charges, meter rent etc. as charged by WBSEDCL. The Concessionaire can pass through the Electricity Tariff to the EV users of PCS as is.
- 2.10. **Operationalization**: Means that EV users have unrestricted access to the charging station and are able to charge their vehicles.
- 2.11. **Operating Time**: means the period during which charging can be carried out at a charging station (by default this is possible 24/7).
- 2.12. Service Charges: The total per unit rate the end user pays to the Charge Point Operator. This includes electricity portion plus service charges excluding applicable taxes. The bill invoice to the consumer must include all cost components such as Electricity Portion, Service Charges, Discounts, Penalties, Taxes etc.

3 Scope of Work

Supply, Installation, operation and Management of Electric Vehicle Charging Station/ Battery Swapping stations at the cost of bidders. The tentative locations across West Bengal under WBSEDCL Jurisdiction is enclosed as Annexure-A. Approximate Area/Space with geo location for setting up EV Charging / Battery Swapping Stations are also furnished against each location in Annexure A.

Necessary physical verification of site & technical feasibility study shall be done by the applicant before submission of the bid.

Maximum Contractual demand per connection: upto 200 KVA

The selected agency shall:

EV Chargers shall support 2 Wheeler, 3 Wheeler or 4 Wheeler.

- 3.1 Plan, Design, Develop, Invest in, Operate and Maintain the interoperable Electric Vehicle Chargers / Battery Swapping systems along with its associated infrastructure for 2 wheeler, 3 wheeler or 4 wheeler. Manage the business in an unmanned / smart way.
- 3.2 pay necessary cost for effecting service connection from LV side of distribution transformer to meter along with security deposit as per applicable rate for the



quantum of power. Necessary electrical infrastructure upto 200 KVA load demand for EV charging station's connection shall be developed by WBSEDCL at each location.

- 3.3 apply for Prepaid/Postpaid metering as applicable. In case of prepaid metering, no security deposit is required.
- 3.4 Apply for an electrical connection within 30 days of the signing of the contract agreement to the respective offices of WBSEDCL. WBSEDCL shall provide requisite connections.
- 3.5 Pay the Monthly Electricity bill of the EV Charging/ Swapping Station set up timely as per applicable tariff of WBSEDCL for electric vehicle charging stations
- 3.6 Extend all necessary support to WBSEDCL for smoother and faster creation of EV charging station in West Bengal. Engage network service provider for providing on line information of the location & other parameters of public Charging Station as per guidelines of MoP in consultation with WBSEDCL.
- 3.7 Utilize the space only for the purpose of Public Charging stations / Battery Swapping systems of EVs. No other activities will be allowed at the locations.
- 3.8 Bear the cost associated with civil works for public charging station/Battery swapping systems of EVs (e.g- cost related to demarcation of the space /land, separate entry/exist and other allied works as per requirement of site).
- 3.9.1 The public charging station should have one number of fast charger @ 30 KW and above and one number of slow/moderate charger. Additionally agency/bidder may install more numbers of chargers based on space availability and demand. Further, maximum of one numbers of battery swapping facility/kiosk can be installed which is also an option based on the demand/requirement.
- 3.9.2 The safety and security of the vehicles that are utilizing the charging facility will be the responsibility of the Operator.
- 3.9.3. The charging infrastructure should be operationalized with minimum mandate as defined above within 180 days from date of handing over the site/location.

4 Engagement Period

The contract agreement will be valid for a period of 120 months from the date of handing over the site. Upon the end of the engagement period, all the equipments/Chargers should be dismantled and taken custody to the agency.



5 About Locations

- 5.1. Locations for setting Public Charging Stations (PCS) will be allotted on concessional basis initially for an engagement Period of 120 months with clearly demarcated service level agreements (SLA) as delineated in Section 11.0.
- 5.2. All costs associated with the installation of upstream electrical infrastructure including installation of Distribution Transformer against each site upto 200 KVA load demand for EV charging station shall be developed by WBSEDCL except the cost of service connection from LV side of distribution transformer to meter.
- 5.3. The locations listed in Annexure-1 are tentative in nature and concessionaire shall have rights to install infrastructure for EV charging station only after executing agreement with WBSEDCL.
- 5.4. The costs associated with civil works on any locations (e.g- cost related to demarcation of the space /land, separate entry/exist and other allied works as per requirement of site) shall be the responsibility of the agency/bidder.
- 5.5. WBSEDCL reserves the right to alter the exact location of any of the sites and offer the agency a new site in the proximity of the site being replaced. In such a scenario, agency will be required to fulfill all mandates mentioned in any part of this document on the new site.

6 Public Charging Stations - Mandates

- 6.1. Charging Station installed at each location is termed as a Public Charging Station (PCS). A PCS should have a minimum number of fast and slow chargers. Additionally, bidder is at liberty to install more number of EVSEs based on space availability and demand. Further, maximum of 01 no. of Battery Swapping Facility / Kiosk can be installed which is an option based on the demand / requirement.
- 6.2. All the AC or DC chargers which meet the standards defined as per Ministry of Power (MOP) Notification vide No 12/2/2018-EV dated 14th January 2022 titled "Charging infrastructure for Electric Vehicles Revised Guidelines and Standards reg' and subsequent amendments thereof. Additionally, each PCS and BSF should adhere to all other standards/conditions defined in any part of this document.
- 6.3. Allowable maximum rate of service charges is @ Rs 18.00 per KWH or the rate defined in the guideline of state of W.B/GOI. The rate is excluding GST.
- 6.4. The minimum mandates for each location should be operationalized in the period defined in Clause 3.9.1. The failure to operationalize the mandates will lead to weekly penalty as defined in SLA under Clause 11.0 of this section.
- 6.5. The agency must submit an operationalization plan within 28 days from the date of agreement.
- 6.6. PCS should be made operational only after requisite clearances are obtained as per CEA Regulations 2019.



- 6.7. The bidder shall make arrangements to adhere to the Central Electricity Authority (Technical Standards for Connectivity of the Distributed Generation Resources) Amendment Regulations, 2019 and Central Electricity Authority (Cyber Security in Power Sector) Guidelines 2021 and amendments from time to time.
- 6.8. The agency shall integrate the EVSEs with WBSEDCL mobile app within 30 days of operationalisation.

7 Charging Station Functionalities

This section defines the features and functionalities that the charging stations shall follow for convenience of the EV Users. The concessionaire must ensure the following:

7.1 User functionalities

- 7.1.1. Charging station must support at least the following functionalities for EV users:
- 7.1.1.1. Location of charging station (Address of the charging station along with the GPS coordinates)
- 7.1.1.2. Charging station operating hours
- 7.1.1.3. Type of chargers and batteries (for swapping at the charging station.
- 7.1.1.4. Availability of slots at charging station (Whether the EVSE is connected to an EV or not)
- 7.1.1.5. Availability of charged battery at battery swapping facility.
- 7.1.1.6. Waiting time and option for booking a slot in case of congestion (Whether the charger is available or booked for particular slots)
- 7.1.1.7. Cost to the consumer for all types of chargers in a location.
- 7.1.1.8. Fare structure for swapping all types of batteries available at the BSF.
- 7.1.1.9. Authentication methods available (at least 2 methods: app-based and RFID cards)
- 7.1.1.10. Option to lodge a complaint for non-functioning charging station.
- 7.1.1.11. Payment methods available
- 7.1.2. The licensee should use an authorized IoS (Internet of Services), IT services to fulfil the requirements in the aforementioned point. The EV user must be able to access these services through a mobile application, including the ability to make payment through the mobile application.

7.2 <u>Communication Requirements</u>

- 7.2.1 Digital Communication between the EVSE and the EV: For DC charging, the digital communication as described in IEC 61851-24 / IS17017must be provided to allow the EV to control the EV supply equipment.
- 7.2.2 Digital Communication between the EVSE and the Charger Management System: The communication between any charger and the charger management system of the Concessionaire must mandatorily use the communication protocol OCPP 1.6 or higher version compatible with OCPP 1.6 or IEC 61850-90-8/ IS17017. The interface between the charger and Concessionaire must be reliable internet connectivity (Ethernet, 3G/4G). Telecommunication network or telecommunication port of the EV supply equipment, connected to the telecommunication network, must comply with the requirements for connection to telecommunication networks according to 6 of IS 13252 (Part 1): 2010.
- 7.2.3 Digital Communication between the Charger Management System and the DISCOM: The communication between EVSE and DISCOM shall be OSCP 10 or (OpenADR + IEEE 2030.5) or IEC 61850-90-8/ IS17017 protocol or higher version of these protocols as and when



notified by State Nodal Agency. The Concessionaire must have provision for the data to be made available for the State Nodal Agency, DISCOM or an external agency as and when notified by WBSEDCL.

7.2.4 Digital Communication between different Charging Stations: The Concessionaire shall make provision for communication with other Charging Stations if required or as and when notified by WBSEDCL, The communication between the two Charging Stations shall be either OCPI 2.1 protocol or OCHP direct 0.2 or higher version of these protocols as and when released.

7.3 <u>Data Sharing Requirements</u>

The Concessionaire shall make provision that the following information would be made available to its respective DISCOM on a regular basis as agreed upon by respective DISCOM:

- 7.3.1. Peak hours of charging EVs
- 7.3.2. Real-time power consumption from charging from each charge point (using smart meters)
- 7.3.3. Session Start & Stop for each charger (Timings & Duration)
- 7.3.4. Instantaneous current flow to EV
- 7.3.5. Instantaneous AC RMS supply voltage
- 7.3.6. Instantaneous active power imported by EV (W or kW)
- 7.3.7. Instantaneous power factor of total energy flow
- 7.3.8. Charger ID
- 7.3.9. Location (GPS coordinates)
- 7.3.10. Emergency Stop (along with reasons), if any
- 7.3.11. Frequency of any voltage fluctuation issue

8 Information to open database

- 8.1. The licensee must make provision that the following information would be made available to the open database managed by State Nodal Agency. The data standards for the data to be submitted are provided in Annexure-4.
- 8.1.1. Station level data
- 8.1.1.1. Name of the charging station
- 8.1.1.2. Location (Latitude, Longitude)
- 8.1.1.3. Operator name and contact details. URL
- 8.1.1.4. Modes of payment accepted
- 8.1.1.5. Maximum Number of Vehicles that can be charged simultaneously
- 8.1.1.6. Advance booking availability
- 8.1.1.7. Operating hours and days
- 8.1.1.8. Operating status operational or upcoming)
- 8.1.1.9. Fare structure Price (INR per kWh or INT/main or combination of both) per battery swapped
- 8.1.1.10. Number of EVs charged of each category per day, number of batteries swapped per day and number of batteries available for swapping in a day



- 8.1.2. Charging unit level data
- 8.1.2.1. ID of the charging unit
- 8.1.2.2. Type of charging gun along with quantity of each and the capacity of each charging gun
- 8.1.2.3. Capacity of battery swapping facility number of batteries and charging capacity of each battery
- 8.1.2.4. Operating status Connected or Available or Out of Service
- 8.1.2.5. Maintenance alerts
- 8.1.2.6. Usage statistics- timestamps of charging usage
- 8.1.2.7. Power consumption- Separately for coach charging point and battery swapping facility
- 8.1.2.8. Availability of slots for reservation

9 Safety Norms

- 9.1. All PCS should be incorporated with suitable protection and monitoring devices for safe and reliable operation of charging stations All PCS must follow the following safety norms:
- 9.1.1. Safety provisions for charging stations vide schedule XVI of the CEA (Technical Standards for Connectivity of Distributed Generation Sources) Regulations, 2013
- 9.1.2. Concessionaire shall keep the records to an extent that the PCS installation have been carried out and maintained in accordance with safety norms as per the relevant CEA Regulation & manufacturer's installation and maintenance instructions
- 9.1.3. Use the armored type cable from the PCS to Electric Vehicle and maximum length shall be restricted to 5 meters
- 9.1.4. PCS should be installed so that any socket-outlet of supply is at least 800 mm above the finished ground level.
- 9.1.5. Protection against the overload of the charging supply and incoming supply fittings must be provided.
- 9.1.6. Shall supplied from a sub-circuit protected by a voltage independent RCD providing personal protection that is compatible with a charging supply for an EVs
- 9.1.7. Shall be supplied from a dedicated final sub circuit
- 9.2. The bidder must ensure that the licensed space for PCS must not be misused due to actions such as intentional /unintentional blocking of parking space by vehicles which are not being charged, utilization of space for other commercial purposes, displaying advertisements etc.

10 Billing and payment requirements

- 10.1. Metering Metering as per Indian standards must be ensured for power consumption by EV chargers at the EV charging station. One service connection must be taken by the bidder from WBSEDCL for EV Charging station. Promotional tariff for Electric Vehicle Charging Station is implemented by WBSEDCL. The Gist of tariff order for the year 2022-23 is available in www.wbsedcl.in portal. Billing shall be done as per tariff order.
- **10.2 Service charges:** Allowable maximum rate of service charges for public EV charging is considered as @ Rs. 18.00 per KWH or the rate defined in the guideline of state of WB/GoI. The rate is excluding GST.
- **10.3 Billing-** EV user must be provided with a bill stating the cost distribution in detail.



10.4. Payment- BHIM, UPI, NFC, RFID and mobile wallet/App based compliant mobile application payment. .

11 Service Level Agreement (SLA)

The agency must adhere to the following Service level agreements with respect to all PCS in a Package.

11.1. The SLAs and penalties against the SLAs are as follows:

- 11.2. The Concessionaire must ensure a Monthly Uptime Percentage of 90% on each individual chargers (excluding for power failure related downtime and scheduled downtime) which means that charging services should be operational and available to the EV users at least 90% of the time in any calendar month.
- 11.3. Concessionaires should display at its office, operating site, OEM dealership location, its website/app or through newspaper advertisement, the procedure to subscribe and use its energy services, the pricing information and contact details of its customer care service.
- 11.4. The agency should allow user-initiated cancellation of its subscription services and refund any security deposit or wallet credits within 15 working days from the date of cancellation application.
- 11.5. Concessionaires should follow applicable regulations with regards to protection of any KYC or personal information collected during application.
- 11.6. The agency will be solely responsible for ensuring the safety of the property and users at the PSC site. Proper monitoring of the PCS site must be ensured to prevent damage to the property.
- 11.7. The Concessionaire will provide a monthly report to WBSEDCL on all the SLA listed under Section 11. If the SLA violated for three consecutive months, then the Concessionaire will be penalized by WBSEDCL. This penalty amount is subject to a maximum of INR 50,000 per site, post which WBSEDCL reserves the right to cancel the contract of the concessionaire for the entire package. WBSEDCL, at its discretion, may choose to ascertain the veracity of the monthly report submitted by the Concessionaire.

12 **Electricity**

- 12.1. The agency shall be responsible for all electricity costs of the PCS by obtaining separately metered electricity service. WBSEDCL shall reasonably cooperate with contractor/bidder efforts regarding the provision of electricity to the charging station. Neither WBSEDCL nor bidder has any responsibility or liability for interruption, curtailment, failure, or defect in the supply or character of utilities furnished to the PCS, unless the cause of the interruption is covered by the party's indemnity.
- 12.2. The agency must ensure that the following (rules and amendments thereto) are followed during the operation and maintenance of the PCS and battery swapping facility.
- 12.2.1. The Electricity Act 2003 any rules/amendments pertaining to EV charging stations and battery swapping stations.
- 12.2.2. CEA (Measures relating to Safety & Electrical supply) Regulations 2010 and its subsequent amendments.
- 12.2.3. Ministry of Power (MoP) Notification vide No 12/2/2018-EV dated 14th January 2022 titled Charging infrastructure for Electric Vehicles Revised Guidelines and Standards reg' and subsequent amendments thereof. In case of any conflict between any section of the aforementioned notification and any section of this tender document, the provisions of the section of this tender document shall prevail.

13 Force majeure

This SLA does not apply to any services that expressly exclude this SLA as stated in the documentation for such services or any performance caused by force Majeure.

14 Other requirements

- 14.1. The agency shall remove and dispose of all excess construction material, waste material, unused fill or other debris left over from excavation or construction, and upon completion of work.
- 14.2. The agency shall post installation, furnish a test certificate, reports for conforming with the standards, to concerned authorities of WBSEDCL.
- 14.3. The charging station must be tested to ensure all on-site and communication connections are working to the specifications of the unit.

15 Branding Guidelines

The Government of West Bengal has introduced the Electric Vehicle Policy'2021 to place West Bengal as a frontrunner in building a sustainable transportation infrastructure by promoting the electric mobility ecosystem in state thereby promoting, sustainability, and energy efficiency. Public charging stations are integral part for promoting e-vehicle in the state. For higher salience and ease of recognition among all EV users across the state, all the Public charging stations should have a common look and feel. To maintain uniformity, branding, and design of the charging stations should be done as per the guidelines suggested below.

15.1 General guidelines

Colour palette: Brand colors to be used for any communication at the Charging station shall be defined by WBSEDCL and the exact colour palette will be predefined. Any collateral must strictly make use of the pre-defined palette. Exact colour palette details will be provided by WBSEDCL at the stage of the signing of the contract agreement with the Concessionaire.

15.2 Logos and images

- 15.2.1. All collateral will have standardized elements such as the logo of EV Charging Station that shall be provided by WBSEDCL.
- 15.2.2. The creative for the logos will be provided by the WBSEDCL along with guidelines pertaining to their use at a later stage.

15.3 Materials to use and not to use - Recommended guidelines

- 15.3.1. Materials used throughout the construction of the charging station should reflect the ecofriendly nature of Electric Vehicles.
- 15.3.2. Luminescent paint should be used to facilitate better visibility.
- 15.3.3. Any stickers used should be reflective in nature.

15.4 Charging bays

- 15.4.1. A charging bay is a key area for charging the vehicle. At each changing bay, there are facilities for comfortable parking of the Electric Vehicle and a charging point to charge the EV. Charging bays may consist of fast chargers or slow chargers or battery swapping facilities.
- 15.4.2. Slow charger should be mounted on a pedestal of suitable height.
- 15.4.3. On the panel of non-slow chargers too, the standardized logo of EV Charging Station must be displayed, as provided by the WBSEDCL.
- 15.4.4. For the charging bay floor area, the pavement will need to be coloured green as per the design given by the WBSEDCL.
- 15.4.5. Vehicle stoppers shall be provided for preventing vehicle from crashing into the chargers.

15.5 Canopy

- 15.5.1. Every Charging Point should be covered by a canopy to protect it from adverse weather conditions. The canopy design shall be standardized by the WBSEDCL and design details of the same shall be shared at the stage of the signing of the contract agreement with Concessionaire.
- 15.5.2. The canopy should be clearly signposted with the Charging point description and should include standardized elements as defined in section 15.2.1.
- 15.5.3 The canopy roof should be made of transparent polycarbonate sheets or glass and The supporting pillars of canopy will be made of stainless steel.

15.6 Tower

- 15.6.1. A prominent tower display must be installed at the entrance of the public charging stations akin to towers displayed at the entrance of fuel stations. The display should specify the configurations of chargers available at the charging station along with the charging rates.
- 15.6.2. The tower should be about 20 feet in height with white backlit background light.
- 15.6.3. The tower design details and specifications shall be shared at the stage of the signing of the contract agreement with Concessionaire.

15.6 Entry Exit and Navigation Signage

- 15.7.1. Entry and exit gates should have a welcome and thank you message respectively for customers along with the standardized elements .
- 15.7.2. Entry point, exit point, and various charging points should be clearly and uniformly signposted throughout the charging station.
- 15.7.3. Design details of all these signposts shall be provided by the WBSEDCL.

15.7 **Operation of Charging Station**

15.8.1. All the charging station preferably be operated in unmanned/smart way. So necessary user-friendly system is to be developed by the agency for collection via online gateway and charging the EV thereafter by the EV user itself.

15.8 Charging Station Signage/Banner

15.9.1. The charging station will have a signage/banner in a standard design as provided by the WBSEDCL which can include the name of the agency. The banner will be prominently located at an area of high visibility near the entrance of the charging station.
