Necessary Earnest Money Deposit (E.M.D.) should be remitted separately through online mode and the same should be documented and scanned copy of the aforesaid documents is to be uploaded through said website as per schedule stated in Sl. No. 1. (Details of which has been narrated in the 'Instruction to the Bidders'). E.M.D. collected via online mode will be settled automatically from e-tendering portal maintained by the National Informatics Centre (NIC) wherein E.M.D. for rejected or unsuccessful bids shall be refunded in the bank account of participating bidders directly from NIC Portal.
- Both Technical Bid and Financial Bid should be submitted in technical and financial folder concurrently duly digitally signed by the Tenderer through the website : <https://wbtenders.gov.in>.
- Technical Document and Other Statutory requirement should be submitted online on or before as per the „Date & Time Schedule“ stated in Table 1.
- The FINANCIAL OFFER of the prospective tenderer will be considered only if the TECHNICAL DOCUMENT of the tenderer found qualified by the Tender Inviting Authority. The decision of the Tender Inviting Authority will be final and absolute in this respect. The list of Responsive and Non-Responsive Bidders will be displayed in the website.
- Security Deposit:** In respect of successful Bidder, the Earnest Money after acceptance of Tender shall be Converted as a part of the Security Deposit. The successful Bidder who deposited Earnest Money @ 2% (Two percent) of the amount put to the Tender.
- The Bidder, at his own responsibility and risk is encouraged to visit and examine the site of works and its surroundings and obtained all information that may be necessary for preparing Bid and entering into an agreement for the work /works as mentioned in the NIT, before submitting offer with full satisfaction. The costs for visiting the working site shall be at the bidder own expense.
- Running payment for the work may be made to the executing agency as per availability of fund. The executing agency may not get a running payment unless the gross amount of the running bill is 15 (Fifteen) lakhs or 50% of the tendered amount whichever is less. Provisions in Clause(s) 7, 8 & 9 contained in W.B. Form No. 2911 (ii) so far as they relate to quantum and frequently of payment is to be treated as superseded.
- No mobilization advance and secured advance will be allowed.**
- Constructional Labour Welfare Cess @ 1% (One percent) of cost of construction will be deducted from every bill of the selected agency, which is included in the rate of items provided in the P.W.D Schedule of Rates.

11. Constructional Labour Welfare Cess @ 1% (One percent) of cost of construction will be deducted from every bill of the ~~Contracted~~ agency, which is included in the rate of items provided in the P.W.D Schedule of Rates.

12. Bid shall remain valid for a period not less than 180 (One Hundred and Eighty) days from the date of opening of financial bid. If the bidder withdraws the bid during the validity period of bid, the earnest money as deposited will be forfeited without assigning any reason thereof.

13. All bids in the range of -20% to -80% of the estimated cost shall furnish an Additional Performance Security in the form of Bank Guarantee (Annexure – VII) from any scheduled Bank, which shall be equal to 10% of the Tendered amount.

14. Earnest Money: Earnest Money/ Bid guarantee amounting to 2% (Two Percent) of the estimated amount /Tender Amount shall be submitted through online mode through the e-Tendering portal (<https://wbtenders.gov.in>). All offline


instruments like Bank Draft, Pay Order etc. will be stopped for e-tender procurement. In case of unsuccessful/ reject bids, the EMD shall be refunded directly from the e-Tendering portal.

15. The Bidder, at his own responsibility and risk is encouraged to visit and examine the site of works and its surroundings and obtain all information that may be necessary for preparing the bid and entering into a contract for the work as mentioned in the Notice Inviting Tender (N.I.T.), before submitting offer. The cost of visiting the site shall be borne by the bidder.
16. The intending bidders shall clearly understand that whatever may be the outcome of the present invitation of bids, no cost of bidding shall be reimbursable by the Department. The Department reserves the right to accept or reject any offer without assigning any reason whatsoever as is not liable for any cost that might have been incurred by any bidder at any stage of bidding.
17. Prospective applicants are advised to note carefully the minimum qualification criteria mentioned in "Instructions to Bidders" stated in Section -"A" before putting up their bids/tenders for the works.
18. Conditional/Incomplete tender will not be accepted under any circumstances.
19. The intending bidder(s) are required to quote the rate online.
20. During scrutiny, if it comes to the notice of the tender inviting authority that the credential or any other paper of any bidder is incorrect/manufactured/fabricated, that bidder would not be allowed to participate in the tender and the application of the said bidder will be rejected without any prejudice.
21. The department reserves the right to cancel the N.I.T. due to unavoidable circumstances and without assigning any reason whatsoever, and no claim from any bidder, will be entertained in this respect.
22. **Qualification criteria:** The tender inviting and accepting authority will determine the eligibility of each bidder. The bidders shall have to meet all the minimum criteria regarding:
 - A) Experience/Credential.
 - B) Financial capacity.The eligibility of a bidder will be ascertained on the basis of the document(s) in support of the minimum criteria as mentioned in (A)&(B) above and the declaration(s) executed as per enclosed Annexure(s) III, IV, V and Annexure VIII. If any document submitted by a bidder is either manufactured or false, the eligibility of the bidder will be rejected at any stage without any prejudice.
23. If any discrepancy arises between two similar clauses on different notification, the clause as stated in later notification will supersede former one in following sequence:
 - A) N.I.T.
 - B) Special terms & Conditions.
 - C) Technical Bid.
 - D) Financial Bid.
24. **Receiving of Earnest Money Deposit (EMD):** EMD should be remitted separately through online mode or in the form of Bank Guarantee in full on any schedule commercial bank in the annexed format and the same should be documented and scanned copy of the aforesaid documents is to be uploaded through said website as per schedule stated in Sl. No. 1. (Details of which has been narrated in the 'Instruction to the Bidders').

25. Return of EMD of the Unsuccessful tenderer(s): The Earnest Money collected via online mode will be settled automatically from e-tendering portal maintained by the National Informatics Centre (NIC) wherein E.M.D. for rejected or unsuccessful bids shall be refunded in the bank account of participating bidders directly from NIC Portal.
