Enterprises etc. who is technically qualified and have successfully completed similar nature of work during last 7 (Seven) years as detailed in clause 6.1 below. [Submission of Bid through online]

In the event of e-filing intending bidder may download the tender document from the website <https://wbenders.gov.in> directly with the help of Digital Signature Certificate. 02% (Two) percent of the estimated amount in the form of EMD is payable online through the website <https://wbenders.gov.in>. No cost of tender documents to be paid.
2. Scope of work: (A) Dismantling of 6.3 MVA, 33/11 KV rated power transformer, Sl.No. 75210, mfg. 2000, Make - Marsons Ltd. lifting from the plinth of power transformer, dragging it from the plinth side to the entrance road of the Islampur 33/11 kv Sub-Station at a distance of 60 mtrs., loading the dismantled PTR in the truck with the help of 02 nos. hydras, carrying the same PTR from Islampur Sub-Station to Kanki Sub-Station for a vehicle plyable road distance of 70 kms., unloading the same at Kanki Sub-Station, dragging the same to place the PTR near the plinth, lifting of the PTR above the plinth, re-fixing of all the dismantled accessories, filling up the oil to make it ready for charging at Kanki Sub-Station (PTR oil was drained out at Islampur Sub-Station and radiator also made dismantled);  
(B) Dismantling of 6.3 MVA (PTR), 33/11 KV rated power transformer Sl.No. 62856, mfg: 1994, Make- Marsons Ltd. lifting from the temporary plinth of power transformer, dragging it from the plinth side to the entrance road of the Raiganj Sub-Station at a distance of 70 mtrs., loading the dismantled PTR in the truck with the help of 02 nos. hydras, carrying the same PTR from Raiganj Sub-Station to a safer place at Kanki Sub-Station after making a journey for a vehicle plyable road distance of 60 kms., unloading the same at a safer place at Kanki Sub-Station, dragging the same to the place for plinth, re-fixing of all the dismantled

accessories, filling up the oil & arranging for resting of the PTR at Kanki Sub-Station (PTR oil was drained out at Raiganj Sub-Station and radiator also made dismantled there.)

3. Both Technical Bid and Financial Bid should be submitted duly digitally signed by the Tenderer through the website <https://wbtenders.gov.in>.
4. Technical Document and Other Statutory requirement should be submitted online on or before as per the 'Date & Time Schedule'.
5. The FINANCIAL OFFER of the prospective tenderer will be considered only if the TECHNICAL DOCUMENT of the tenderer found qualified by the Tender Inviting Authority. The decision of the Tender Inviting Authority will be final and absolute in this respect. The list of Responsive and Non-Responsive Bidders will be displayed in the website.

7. Eligibility criteria for participation in the tender:
  - 7.1. Bonafide, experienced & resourceful contractors of Govt., Semi Govt., Govt. undertaking Organizations, Govt. Enterprises etc. who have successfully completed similar nature of work like shifting and maintenance of 6.3 MVA PTR during last 7 (Seven) years are only eligible to participate in the tender. Order copy along with Completion Certificate/payment certificates indicating Estimated amount, Ordered amount, value of work done, Date of scheduled and actual completion of work, details communicational address along with email and contact no. of the client should be submitted by the bidder. Completion certificate from the concerned Executive Engineer/District engineer/Divisional Engineer or equivalent rank and above will be treated as valid credential. [Non-statutory documents]
  - 7.2. All intending Bidders are required to produce valid copies of GST Registration certificate & GST Return, Professional Tax enrolment certificate (PT) deposit challans for the last month, ESI registration/Workmen Compensation Certificate/Medical Insurance for labours if applicable, copy of IT return for last three assessment years i.e. 2022-23, 2021-22, 2020-21; PAN, EPF registration, Electrical Contractor's License issued under Act, Documents in support of Credential such as copy of orders and completion certificates (to be documented through e-filing). [Non-statutory documents]
  - 7.3. Registered labour Co-operative Societies are required to furnish valid Bye law, current Audit report, Minutes of last A.G.M, valid certificate from A.R.C.S along with other relevant supporting papers. [Non-statutory documents]
  - 7.4. Income tax Acknowledgement Receipt for the latest Assessment year, P.T Deposit challan, PAN card, IT return of last three assessment years i.e. 2022-23, 2021-22, 2020-21, GST Registration Certificate along with GST Return are to be accompanied with the technical bid documents. [Non-statutory documents]
  - 7.5. The prospective bidders or any of their constituent partner shall neither have abandoned any work nor any of their contract have been rescinded during the last 05(five) years. Such abandonment or rescission will be considered as disqualification towards eligibility. (A declaration in this respect through affidavit has to be furnished by the prospective bidders without which the Technical Bid shall be treated as non responsive.) [Non-statutory documents]
  - 7.6. The prospective bidders should own or arrange through lease hold registered agreement, the required plant and machineries. Conclusive proof of ownership in favour of owner or leaser of plant and machineries in working condition shall have to be submitted.
  - 7.7. Registered Partnership Deed for partnership firm only along with power of Attorney is to be submitted. The company shall furnish the article of Association and Memorandum. [Non-statutory documents]
  - 7.8. Joint ventures will not be allowed.

- 7.9. A prospective bidder shall be allowed to participate in a particular job either in the capacity of individual or as a partner of a firm. If found to have applied severally in a job, all his applications will be rejected for that job without assigning thereof.
8. No mobilization / secured advance will be allowed.
9. Running payment for the work may be made to the executing Agency as per availability of fund. The executing agency may not get a running payment unless the gross amount of the running bill is 50 (fifty) lakhs or 20 % of the tendered amount whichever is less. Provisions in Clause 7,8& 9 contained in W.B form no. 2911(ii) so far as they related to quantum and frequency of payments is to be treated as superseded.
10. Constructional Labour welfare Cess @ 1% (one percent) of cost of construction will be deducted from every Bill. All other statutory levy / Cess as applicable will have to be borne by the contractor & the rate in the schedule of rates are inclusive of all such taxes and Cess as stated above. The estimated cost is exclusive of GST. GST will be admissible as per prevailing rates and rules in force.
11. **Bids shall remain valid for a period not less than 180 (One hundred eighty) days after date of financial Bid opening of tender. Bid valid for a shorter period shall be rejected by the Tender Inviting Authority as non-responsive. If the tenderer withdraws the bid before the period of bid validity without giving any satisfactory explanation for such withdrawals, the earnest money as deposited will be forfeited forthwith without assigning any reason thereof.**
12. **Earnest Money / Bid Guarantee:** The amount of Earnest money @ 2% of the estimated amount put to tender to be submitted online in <https://wbtenders.gov.in>. In case of BG, the bank guarantee shall be valid for 12(twelve) calendar months with a claim period up to 1 (One) month from the date of submission of bid. Bid guarantee of the unsuccessful bidder will be released after finalization of tender against the prayer of the contractor.  
No interest shall be payable by WBSEDCL on the above Bid guarantee.
13. **Security Deposit:** In respect of successful Bidder, the Earnest Money after acceptance of Tender shall be converted as a part of the Security Deposit. The successful Bidder who deposited Earnest Money @ 2% (Two percent) of the amount put to the Tender, balance of necessary 3% (Three percent) Security Deposit shall be realised by recovering from the progressive bill @ 1% (One percent) of the amount of each such bill. In all cases the amount of recovery of the Final Bill will be so adjusted as to make the total amount of Security Deposit equivalent to 3% (Three percent) to the value of work so executed.
14. The Bidder, at his own responsibility and risk is encouraged to visit and examine the site of works and its surroundings and obtain all information that may be necessary for preparing Bid and entering into an agreement for the work / works as mentioned in the NIT, before submitting offer with full satisfaction. The costs for visiting the working site shall be at the bidder's own expense.
15. The intending Bidders shall clearly understand that whatever may be the outcome of the present invitation of the Bid, no cost of Bidding shall be reimbursable by the Tender Inviting Authority. The Tender Inviting Authority reserves the right to accept or reject any / all offer without assigning any reason whatsoever and is not liable for any cost that might have incurred by the Bidder at the stage of Bidding.
16. Prospective applicants are advised to note carefully the minimum qualification criteria as mentioned in 'Instruction to bidders' stated in Section - 'A' before tendering the bids.
17. Work Order & Payment of work will be dependent on availability of fund. Intending bidders may consider these criteria during submission of tender and quoting their rate through online.
18. No Conditional Bid / Incomplete Tender will be accepted under any circumstances.
19. The intending bidder(s) required to quote the rate in the BOQ (as space provided) over online considering that no escalation and / or price adjustment will be allowed by the department under any circumstances.
20. At any stage during scrutiny, if it is found that the credential or any other papers which the Bidder uploaded during Bidding process, found incorrect / manufactured / fabricated, that bid will be considered a nonresponsive and outright rejected with forfeiture of Earnest Money and action will be taken as per stipulation of IT Rules in force.
21. The Tender Inviting Authority (WBSEDCL) does not bind itself to accept the lowest bidder and reserves the right to accept or reject, split any / all offer without assigning any reason whatsoever and is not liable for any cost that might have incurred by the Bidder at any stage of the Bidding. Tender inviting Authority (WBSEDCL)

also reserves right to accept/cancel/withdraw the concerned NIT in full or part due to unavoidable circumstances and no claim in this respect shall be entertained.

22. Before issuance of Letter of Acceptance / Work order, the tender accepting authority may verify the credential & other documents of the lowest bidder so uploaded online if found necessary. If any such document is found incorrect / manufactured / fabricated, Letter of Acceptance / Work order will not be issued in favor of the bidder under any circumstances and action will be taken accordingly.

23. If any discrepancy arises between two similar clauses on different notification, the clause as stated in later notification will supersede former one in following sequence:

- A) N.I.T
- B) Special terms & conditions.
- C) Technical Bid.
- D) Financial Bid.
