Name of work:** Overhauling work of the installed 132/33 kV, 20 MVA and 12.5 MVA PTR which includes painting, vacuum-hot- filtration of transformer oil, replacement of rubberized Gasket, breathers & silica gel and WTI & OTI along with allied works and vacuum-hot- filtration of transformer oil of 2 nos. 132/6.6 kV, 16 MVA GTR & 2 nos. of 33 kV Earthing Transformer at Power Station-II under TCFHP, WBSEDCL.
- 2. Estimated Cost:** ₹4,89,776/- (Rupees four lakh eighty nine thousand seven hundred seventy six only). GST will be paid extra as per statute.

**4. Eligibility criteria:** The intending bidders must have:

- i) Successfully executed similar type of work i.e. Repair/vacuum-hot-filtration/ overhauling of transformer oil in the minimum category of 132/33 kV grade transformer against a single contract value of minimum executed amount (excluding of GST /Service Tax) of 50% of the estimated cost. Work completed in last seven years of due date of submission shall only be considered.
- ii) Valid Electrical Contractor's License with Supervisory Competency Certificate on appropriate part
- iii) Employees' Provident Fund
- iv) GST Registration certificate
- v) Up to date P. Tax clearance certificate.



- vi) PAN Card
- vii) IT Return for the last three years
- viii) Valid Trade License.

5. **Earnest Money Deposit:** ₹ 12,245/- (Rupees twelve thousand two hundred forty five only) in the form of Demand Draft/Pay Order/Banker's Cheque drawn on any Scheduled Bank in favour of "WBSEDCL A/c No.: 30149574213" payable at Siliguri (West Bengal). The EMD may also be submitted through Bank transfer i.e. RTGS/NEFT to WBSEDCL Account no.: 30149574213, IFSC CODE SBIN0000184. 6. **How to Participate:** Intending bidders will have to download and print the tender from our website **www.wbsedcl.in** under tender. The duly filled tender form along with request papers as in the cheque box may reach this office at Administrative Building, Township Complex, P.O. Phansidewa, Distt. Darjeeling, Pin-734434 (West Bengal) physically or through speed post or courier within **15.06.2022** up to 17:00 hrs. The bid will be opened on **16.06.2022** at 11:30 hrs. Any bid received beyond **15.06.2022**, will not be entertained.

8. The Technical Part shall contain NIT duly signed at each page, EMD, eligibility criteria part, request letter (Annexure-I) and check box. Price part should be submitted on agency's own letter head as per **enclosed Tender Form**.
9. The interested bidders may visit the site to examine the works required for preparing the Bid. The cost of visiting the site shall be at the Bidder's own expense.
10. The tenderers shall keep the Technical part and price part in two separate covers and shall seal it properly. These two inner covers shall be addressed to the Project Manager, TCFHP, WBSEDCL, Phansidewa Township complex, WBSEDCL, Dist: Darjeeling-734434 and shall contain the name of work, tender Notice no. and shall be super-scribed as "TECHNICAL PART" and "PRICE PART" as the case may be. These two sealed inner covers shall be put into an outer cover and be sealed properly.
11. The outer sealed envelope containing the "TECHNICAL PART" and "PRICE PART" in separate sealed covers as stated above, shall be addressed to the Project Manager, TCFHP, Phansidewa Township complex, WBSEDCL, Dist: Darjeeling-734434.
12. Tender Notice No, Due date and name & address of the bidder must be prescribed on the envelope covering the tender.
13. All the papers enclosed with the tender must be signed & sealed by the authorized signatory of the tender.
14. Bid submitted shall remain valid for a minimum period of 180 (one hundred eighty) days from the next date of opening of tender. However, WBSEDCL may, on the merit of case, request extension of validity of the offer for a further suitable period without any change in terms & conditions of the offer.



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5. Conditional / Incomplete tender will not be accepted under any circumstances.
16. Canvassing in connection with the tender is strictly prohibited in the Tender submitted by the Contractor.
17. If the above mentioned office happens to be closed on the date of receipt of application and/or on the date of issue of the Bid Documents and/or on the date of receipt/opening of Bid documents, the next working day at the same time and venue shall be applicable for the said purpose.
18. The WBSEDCL does not bind itself to accept the lowest bidder and reserves the right to reject any or all tender(s) or to split the whole work to more than one contractor without assigning any reason whatsoever.
19. The WBSEDCL reserves the right to cancel the N.I.T. due to unavoidable circumstances and no claim in this respect will be entertained.
20. **Refund of EMD:** In case of unsuccessful bidders, Earnest money Deposit will be refunded after finalization of the tender in the bank account as provided in the **Annexure-I** (To be filled up by the bidder on bidder's own letter head). For successful bidder it will be dealt as per clause Security Deposit.
21. **Security Deposit:** Earnest money of the successful bidder shall be converted into security deposit. Further necessary deduction will be done from RA bill to constitute Security deposit to the tune of 3% (three percent) of the total value of the work actually done. Refund of Security Deposit can be claimed after a period of 06 (six) months of completion of contract period. The same will be refunded after due process on certification of successful completion of contract period and defect liability period by the Controlling Officer.
22. **Defect Liability Period:** The term 'defect liability period' shall mean the period of 06 (six) months from the Date of completion work in all respect. If any defect is found within the defect liability period you shall be liable to rectify/replace the materials at your own cost and responsibility.
23. **Forfeiture of Earnest Money:** Earnest Money shall be forfeited in case of following:
  - i. If during the period of validity, the bidder withdraws its bid as a whole or in part.
  - ii. If the bidder deviates from any clarification/confirmation given by him subsequent to submission of his bid.
  - iii. In case of successful bidder, if the Bidder fails to accept LOA/Order unconditionally.
24. **Evaluation of Bid:** The bids shall be evaluated on the basis of total quoted price for the entire scope of supply covered under this bid document.
25. **Completion time:** The work shall be completed within 60 (Sixty) days from the date of handing over the site.
26. **Payment:** Payment shall be made after successful completion of the entire work through Measurement Book against GST prescribed Invoice.



- 27. Tools & Tackles:** Necessary tools & tackles required for the entire work shall have to be supplied by the agency at his own cost. Only Vacuum-hot -filtration machine for transformer oil filtration shall be provided by WBSEDCL.
- 28. Transportation:** All sorts of transportation of the tools and tackles, consumables etc. of the agency for attending normal and emergency job shall be made by the agency through its own arrangement.
- 29. Accommodation & Electricity Bills:** Accommodation may be provided for the contractor's workmen by WBSEDCL @ ₹ 1,000/- per room per month or at the rate decided by TCFHP authority time to time. Electricity charges shall have to be paid by the contractor as per prevailing rules of WBSEDCL.
- 30. Statutory Obligations Relating To Contract Labour:** Contractor must comply with all rules & regulations of various Labour Acts e.g. Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act 1970; Payment of wages Act, 1936 ; Minimum wages Act, 1948; E.P.F. & MP Act 1952; Workmen's Compensation Act 1923; Building and Other Construction Workers (Regulation of Employment and Condition of Services) Act 1996; Building and Other Construction Workers Welfare Cess Act, 1996; Payment of Bonus Act 1965 or any other laws as applicable relating thereto and rules made there under time to time.
- 31. Labour License:** The agency shall have to furnish labour license issued by Labour Department in respect of the work as per Contract Labour (Regulation & Abolition) Act, 1970 and its amendments as applicable to the work. Agency shall have to abide by all other statutes and norms which are prevailing on the land.
- 32. Nature of work and required Workmanship:** The work being very precise in nature, competent persons need to be deployed for the work.
- 33. Employees Identification:** Successful bidder shall submit his employees' identification to the Controlling Officer. For this purpose, submission of photo employment card in duplicate in Form XIV (prescribed format) under Rule-76 of the Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Central Rules, 1971 and amendments as applicable shall have to be done.
- 34. Work Permit:** Before undertaking the work, the entrusted agency shall have to obtain Work Permit from the department as and when required.
- 35. Safety Regulation:** Contractors shall, at all times at his own cost exercise reasonable and proper precautions for the safety of all people directly or indirectly employed for the execution of the work and shall comply with all safety regulations. WBSEDCL shall not take any responsibilities towards financial compensation due to accident/casualties etc. of any type under this contract. During execution of the work any damage to the WBSEDCL properties incurred by the contractor / contractor's labour shall have to be rectified by the contractor at his own cost and hand over the same to WBSEDCL. However extra care should be taken to avoid such damages during the execution of the contract. The agency have to exercise/abide by the following conditions:
- a) The entrusted agency shall have to provide Safety/Personal Preventive Equipments (PPE) like helmet, safety shoe, safety belt, earthing rod, hand gloves, Gum boots and Raincoats and any other item as per rule as to its working personnel, at agency's own cost.



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b) If the agency fails to provide safety/Personal Preventive Equipment (PPE), then the department may arrange the same and the cost incurred shall be deducted from the agency's bills.

**36. Risk and Insurance:** WBSEDCL shall be in no way held responsible/liable for any accident/mishap, if caused to any personnel/equipment during execution of the work. Any loss/damage caused to any equipment of the department during execution of the work will have to be compensated by the agency to the entire satisfaction of the controlling officer.

**37. Sub-Letting of Contract:** The contractor shall not, without the written consent of the Company, assign or sublet his contract or any part thereof, other than for raw materials, or for any part of the work provided that any such consent shall not relieve the contractor from any obligation, duty or responsibility under the contract. In the event of sub-letting of contract or any part thereof is permitted, the fact that such permission has been accorded shall not establish any contractual relationship between the approved Sub-vendor and WBSEDCL of any of his liabilities and obligations under the contract.

**38. Termination Of Contract:**

- i. If the contractor fails to start the work on the scheduled date or within a reasonable time, the WBSEDCL shall have the right to cancel the Letter of Award /Work Order with forfeiture of earnest money deposit without giving any notice to the contractor.
- ii. If the contractor neglects, or fails to proceed with the work satisfactorily as per requirement, fulfilling terms and conditions of the contract, the WBSEDCL shall have the right to terminate the work order / letter of award after giving notice in writing to the contractor. If the contractor fails, after 14 (fourteen) days of such notice, to proceed the work in the manner notified, the WBSEDCL shall terminate the contract.
- iii. In that case of termination, WBSEDCL shall take possession of the work, site and engage other agency to complete the work. Extra cost, if incurred, to get the unfinished work done through other agency, will be realised from the terminated agency. If the contract is terminated as above, the contractor shall have no claim for compensation against the WBSEDCL for any loss or deterioration of any materials that he may have collected or engagement he may have entered into on account of the work.

**39. Arbitration:** In case, any dispute arises between the contractor and WBSEDCL, the same shall have to be settled mutually and no arbitration in this respect either can be sought for or shall be granted.

**40. Forfeiture Of Earnest Money:** Earnest Money shall be forfeited in case of following:

- i. If during the period of validity, the bidder withdraws its bid as a whole or in part.
- ii. If the bidder deviates from any clarification/confirmation given by him subsequent to submission of his bid.
- iii. In case of successful bidder, if the Bidder fails:
  - a. To accept LOI/Order unconditionally and sign contract.
  - b. To furnish the contract performance bond wherever applicable.



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**Reporting of Accident:** All accidents, major or minor, must be reported immediately to WBSEDCL and the contractor will provide first aid to the injured person immediately. The injured person shall report to the First Aid Station along with the 'Injured on work' form as per appropriate Proforma duly filled in quintuplicate and submit to the Medical Officer of the First Aid Station.

Serious Injuries: In case of serious injuries, the following procedure shall be adopted by the contractor.

To provide first aid at his own First Aid Station.

To take the injured person to the hospital along with the 'Injured on work' form duly filled in.

To report the accident to WBSEDCL.

Fatal Accident: Fatal accidents must be reported immediately to WBSEDCL as well as to the Police.

Penalty: Failure to observe the Safety Rules will make the contractor liable to penalty by way of suspension of work and termination of contract. Adequate arrangement for proper lighting & guarding shall be made at the work site.

- 42. Paying Officer:** The Manager (F&A), TCFHP, Adm. Building, Phansidewa Township Complex, Phansidewa, Dist. Darjeeling, Pin – 734434.
- 43. Controlling Officer:** The Superintending Engineer (E), O&M Division, PS-II, Teesta Canal Fall Hydel Project, Haptiagachh, Dist. Uttar Dinajpur.
- 44. Liquidated Damages:** In case, the work not completed within the schedule completion period due to paucity or incompetence or bad workmanship of work by the workmen of the agency or/and non-availability of tools/tackles and consumables, Liquidated Damages will be imposed at half percent (0.5%) of the Contract price for per week of delay or part thereof for first 10 (ten) weeks and @ 01% of value per week beyond 10 weeks subject to a maximum of 10% of the contract price / Ordered value.
- 45. Force Majeure:** The Agency shall be under no liability if he is prevented from carrying out any of his obligations by reason of war, invasion, act of foreign country, hostilities (whether war declared or not), riots, civil commotion, mutiny, insurrection, rebellion, revolution, accident, earthquake, fires, floods Govt. orders and/or restrictions (except power supply restriction) delay or inability to obtain materials due to import or other statutory restriction and other cause beyond the reasonable control of the supplier. However, such force majeure circumstances are to be intimated immediately and to be established subsequently with proper documents/proofs to the entire satisfaction of the purchaser.
- 46. Extension of time:** An extension of time without imposition of penalty, may be granted for delay in execution of work provided there is no fault whatsoever on the part of the contractor. Such extension may only be granted on the basis of application to be submitted within the schedule date of completion by the contractor who has to establish that the extension of time required by him is not due to his fault.

**Causes for Extension of Time for Completion:** The Contractor may claim an extension of the Time for Completion if he is or will be delayed in completing the Works by any of the following causes:




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- (a) Extra or additional work ordered in writing by WBSEDCL.
- (b) Suspension of work ordered in writing.
- (c) Delay by any other Contractor engaged by WBSEDCL, affecting this Contract.
- (d) The WBSEDCL's Risks, if any when they constitute the sole reason for the delay in completion of Works.
- (e) Delay in handover of site by WBSEDCL.
- (f) Force Majeure.

You shall give notice to WBSEDCL of his intention to make a claim for an extension of time within 07 days of the occurrence of any of the above cause(s). The notice shall be followed as soon as possible by the claim with full supporting details. WBSEDCL shall after verification allow you for updating of the programme chart as facts may justify

**47. MANNER OF EXECUTION OF CONTRACT AGREEMENT:**

- c. The successful bidder has to submit acceptance of the LOI/L.O.A within **10 (ten)** days from the date of issue of the Letter of Intent/order. The successful bidder shall be required to execute an Agreement on a non-judicial stamp paper of ₹100/- with the company with all related documents for satisfactory execution of the work.
  - d. The agreement shall be signed on a date and time to be mutually agreed upon in the office of the ordering authority of the contract and the same has to be signed by both the parties within 30 (thirty) days from date of acceptance of the order. Power of attorney of the authorized representative of the contractor who will sign the contract agreement on behalf of the contractor is to be submitted before signing of the agreement.
  - e. The agreement shall be signed in original and three photo copies. The original agreement shall be retained by the Company and a copy will be handed over to the Contractor.
- 48.** The participating bidders may please note that the successful bidder shall have to submit an Indemnity Bond in the prescribed format before commencement of the work.
- 49. Amendment to the Letter of Award:** So far any modification / additions, if any, to this Letter of Award (L.O.A) are concerned, the extension, amendments, corrigendum, approval for excess quantities, extra items etc. issued by this office shall be considered as valid and applicable to the contract in question.
- 50. Legal Jurisdiction:** If any dispute or difference arises with respect to quality/quantity of the equipment/materials pertaining to this order or any other terms and conditions of the order including its execution, such dispute/difference shall be subject to settlement under the jurisdiction of Courts in Kolkata only
