NOTICE INVITING e-TENDER

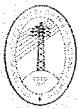
Tenders are invited by the Addl. CE and Project Manager, Teesta Canal Fall Hydel Project, WBSEDCL, Admin. Bldg., Phansidewa, Darjeeling-734434 through electronic tendering (e-tendering) from Original Equipment Manufacturer or channel partner/dealer of Original Equipment Manufacturer for taking up the supply & delivery of LED light fittings and fixtures on **item rate basis**.

1. **Name of work:** Supply & delivery of LED light fittings and fixtures for TCFHP under WBSEDCL as per schedule of supply.
2. **Price Basis:** The Price shall be quoted on FOR TCFHP Store site basis including all charges towards freight & transit insurance, packing & forwarding, unloading & stacking etc. GST will be paid extra as per actual. The quoted prices shall remain FIRM within the bid validity period.
3. **Estimated Cost:** ₹ 42,50,810/- (Rupees forty two lakh fifty thousand eight hundred ten only). GST will be paid extra as per statute.
4. **Earnest Money Deposit:** ₹ 85,016/- (Rupees Eighty Five Thousand Sixteen only). All participating bidders are exempted from payment of Tender Fee. Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) in e-tendering process will be collected and refunded in online mode via dedicated bank account maintained at corporate level instead of depositing Bank Draft/Pay Order/Banker's Cheque to the tender inviting authority. The amount of Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) is to be submitted through online mode through the e-Tendering portal (<https://wbtennders.gov.in>) online. As per the procedure defined for online collection in e-tender process, EMD amount deposited by bidders is initially held in a pool account of Government of West Bengal maintained by ICICI. Only the amount corresponding to successful bid will be transferred to WBSEDCL Bank Account after completion of tendering process on awarding Award of Contract (AOC). For technically rejected bids, EMD amount will be automatically returned to bidders after the bid is technically rejected in e-tender portal. However for successful bids, the EMD will be refunded by WBSEDCL as per norms after completion of tendering process.

The EMD may also be submitted in form of Bank Guarantee (BG) in the format as in **Annexure-VI** valid for a period of 180 (one hundred eighty) days from the date of opening of techno-commercial bid with additional claim period of 90 (ninety) days. Tender without Earnest Money Deposit shall be rejected summarily.

5. Eligibility Criteria:

- i) Original Equipment Manufacturer or channel partner/dealer of Original Equipment Manufacturer of preferred make only.
- ii) Valid GST Registration certificate and GSTR3B or Annual return- GSTR9 for last two years.



- iii) PAN Card.
- iv) Trade License in respect of the prospective Bidder. Proprietorship Firm (Trade License). Partnership Firm (Partnership Deed, Trade License). Ltd Company (Incorporation certificate, Trade License). Co-operative Society (Society Registration copy, Trade License). [Non-statutory Documents].
- v) OEM Authorization Letter/Manufacture's Authorization Form (MAF)/Authorized Dealer Certificate from Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM).

6. Bid Guarantee/Earnest Money:

- a. A bidder desirous of taking part in a tender invited by offices of WBSEDCL shall login to the e-Procurement portal of Government of west Bengal <https://www.wbtenders.gov.in> using his login Id and password.
- b. The bidder shall select the tender to bid and initiate payment of EMD. Following payment options are available for paying EMD amount through online mode:
 - i) **NET-BANKING THROUGH PAYMENT GATEWAY.**
 - ii) **RTGS/NEFT Payment:** On selection of RTGS/ NEFT as the payment mode, the e-Procurement portal will show a pre-filled challan having the details to process RTGS/NEFT transaction. The bidder will print the challan and use the prefilled information to make RTGS/NEFT payment using his bank account. Once the payment is made, the bidder will come back to the e-procurement portal to continue the bidding process after expiry of a reasonable time to enable the RTGS/NEFT process to be completed.
 - iii) Submission of EMD through BG: The bidder can make payment of EMD in the form of Bank Guarantee (BG) from any schedule bank.

- c. **General Instructions for Online Payment:**
 - i) The bidder will have to mandatorily pay through Net-banking facility once Net banking mode is opted for payment.
 - ii) Status of NEFT/RTGS payment through Challan for a bid may take time for bank settlement which is updated in 24 Hrs. (approx.) As such bidders opting to pay through NEFT/RTGS mode shall make payment well before 24 Hrs. to avoid any complicity.
 - iii) In case actual EMD amount as per NIT is more than the one shown in e-Tender Portal, bidders will have to opt for NEFT/RTGS mode (challan mode). In that case the total actual EMD amount is to be paid only through NEFT/RTGS mode (challan mode).



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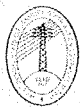
- iv) The bank account used for payment of EMD by the bidders shall be maintained operative until the completion of tendering process. All refunds will be made mandatorily to the Bank A/c from which the payment of EMD has been initiated

d. Refund/ Settlement of EMD Amount:

- i) For unsuccessful bidders, EMD amount submitted through RTGS/NEFT against the tender shall be refunded automatically, through an automated process, by NIC portal on receipt of updated status of any bid. In case of BG submitted as EMD, the same will be released after finalisation of tender.
 - ii) For successful bid(s), EMD will be refunded from WBSEDCL authority after submission of Performance Bank Guaranty. Otherwise the same will be adjusted as Security Deposit.
 - iii) The bank account used for payment of EMD by the bidders shall be maintained operative until the completion of tendering process. All refunds will be made mandatorily to the Bank A/c from which the payment of EMD has been initiated.
 - iv) For any queries related to payments and refunds, bidders will have to communicate with ICICI Customer Support, viz, **033_40267512/13** since payment gateway facility used by E-tender portal is maintained by ICICI
- e. The bid guarantee is required to protect WBSEDCL against the risk of bidder's conduct, which would warrant the bid guarantee forfeiture.
- f. The bid guarantee shall be forfeited:
- i) If during the period of validity specified by the bidder, the bidder withdraws/modifies its bid as a whole or in part.
 - ii) If the bidder deviates from any clarification/confirmation given by him subsequent to submission of his bid.
 - iii) In case of successful bidder, if the bidder fails to accept LOI/LOA/Order unconditionally and sign contract
 - iv) For failure to submit specified performance bank guarantee within time limit indicated in the Purchase Order / LOI.
 - v) If any cartel is formed by the bidder in their quotation.
- g. No interest shall be payable by WBSEDCL on the above bid guarantee/ Earnest money.

Exemption from deposition of Bid Guarantee/Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) shall not be allowed under any circumstances

1. Submission of original copies of Bank Guarantee for Earnest Money Deposit:
 - a. EMD may be submitted in the form of Bank Guarantee.



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- b. Place of submission: The original copies of the Bank Guarantee towards Earnest Money Deposit shall be submitted to the office of the Project Manager, TCFHP, WBSEDCL, Township Complex, P.O. Phansidewa, Dist – Darjeeling, PIN – 734434.
- c. Time of submission: The original copies of Bank Guarantee towards EMD shall be submitted in a sealed envelope in the office as stated above within the date and time as specified in the NIeT. If the bidder fails to submit the original copies within the due date and time as specified in the NIeT, his tender will not be opened and his bid will stand rejected.

7. Process to be Confidential:

- i) After the opening of bids, information relating to the examination, clarification, evaluation and comparison of bids and recommendations concerning the award of contract shall not be disclosed to bidders or other persons not officially concerned with such process.
 - ii) Any effort by a bidder to influence WBSEDCL or other connected in the process of examination, clarification, evaluation and comparison of bids, and in decisions concerning the award of contract, may result in the rejection of his/their bid.
 - iii) Formation of any cartel, may lead to the cancellation of tender with penal measures as necessary and WBSEDCL reserves to right to take such unilateral decisions without further notice to anyone
- 8.** Successful bidder(s) shall have to mandatorily create vendor ID through WBSEDCL Vendor Corner, if not created earlier.
- 9.** In the event of e-filling intending contractors/bidders desirous of participating in the e-Tender should download the tender documents from the website <http://www.wbtenders.gov.in> directly with the help of Digital signature Certificate.
- 10.** Both **Technical Bid and Financial Bid** are to be submitted concurrently duly digitally signed by the Bidder through the website <https://wbtenders.gov.in> and should be submitted online on or before as per the 'Date &Time Schedule'.
- 11.** The FINANCIAL OFFER of the prospective bidder will be considered only if the TECHNICAL BID of the Bidder is found qualified by the WBSEDCL. The decision of the WBSEDCL will be final and absolute in this respect. The list of Qualified Bidders of Technical Bid will be displayed in the website.
- 12.** No mobilization advance and secured advance will be allowed.
- 13.** A prospective Bidder shall be allowed to participate in the tender only in one legal capacity, namely as an individual, Sole Proprietor, Partnership Firm/LLP, Company or any other legally recognized entity. No person or entity shall directly or indirectly submit or be associated with more than one bid for the same tender. Any violation of this condition shall liable to rejection.
- 14.** The offer against tender should remain valid for a minimum period of 180 days from the next day of opening of the tender (Financial Bid opening date). However, WBSEDCL may, on the merit of case, request for extension of validity of the offer for a further suitable period without any change in terms & conditions of the offer.



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15. The instant e-NIT will be processed in line with prevailing Revised Purchase Policy of WBSEDCL as available in <http://www.wbsedcl.in> website.

The Bidder at the Bidder's own responsibility and risk is encouraged to visit and examine the site of works and its surroundings and obtain all information that may be necessary for preparing the Bid and entering into a contract for the work as mentioned in the Notice Inviting Tender. The cost of visiting the site shall be at the Bidder's own expense.

19. **Evaluation of Bid:** The bids shall be evaluated in two steps. After successful evaluation of Technical Bids, Financial Bids will be opened only for Technically Qualified Bidders on the basis of total quoted price for the entire scope of work covered under this bid document.

20. The intending Bidders shall clearly understand that whatever may be the outcome of the present invitation of Bids, no cost of Bidding shall be reimbursable by the WBSEDCL. The WBSEDCL reserves the right to accept or reject any offer without assigning any reason whatsoever and is not liable for any cost that might have been incurred by any Bidder at any stage of Bidding.

21. Prospective applicants are advised to note carefully the minimum qualification criteria before tendering the bids.

22. Conditional / Incomplete tender will not be accepted under any circumstances.

23. The intending Bidders are required to quote the rate online at www.wbtenders.gov.in

24. Canvassing in connection with the tender is strictly prohibited in the Tender submitted by the Contractor.



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25. The eligibility of a Bidder will be ascertained on the basis of the documents submitted by the Bidder in support of eligibility criteria. If any document submitted by a Bidder is incorrect / manufactured / fabricated or false at any stage, his Tender will be out rightly rejected and legal action will be taken against him.
26. The WBSEDCL does not bind itself to accept the lowest bidder and reserves the right to reject any or all tender(s) or to split the whole work to more than one contractor without assigning any reason whatsoever.
27. Revised Purchase Policy will be followed wherever applicable in respect of the contract work. Revised Purchase Policy is available at company's website.
28. The WBSEDCL reserves the right to cancel the N.I.T. due to unavoidable circumstances and no claim in this respect will be entertained.
