The Chief Engineer and Project Manager, Purulia Pumped Storage Project, WBSEDCL invites e-tender from bonafide eligible, resourceful and experienced contractors having requisite credentials of similar nature of works in Govt. /Semi Govt. 2. Both Technical and Financial Bids are to be submitted concurrently duly digitally signed by the Bidder through the website https://wbtenders.gov.in. (Details of which has been narrated in "Instruction to Bidders").

3. Eligibility criteria for participation in tender:

a) i)Technical: The bidders shall have credential for successfully performed Erection or Overhauling work of minimum one no. 1 MW of Turbine Generator Set of Hydel Power Plant during last 7(seven) years.

b) ii)Financial:Bonafied, experienced & Resourceful contractors who have successfully completed: (i) At least one no. of work as mentioned in Sl. No. a(i costing not less than 80% of the estimated price, (ii) Two similar works of value not less than 50% each (iii) Three similar works of value not less than 40% of similar works each. Completion Certificate indicating Estimated Amount, Value of work-done, Date of completion of the work and detail communication address along with contact number of the Client should be

submitted by the Bidder. Completion Certificate from the concerned Project Manager/Executive Engineer /Divisional Engineer or equivalent rank and above will be treated as valid credential. [Non-statutory Documents]

- c) Must have achieved minimum average annual turnover of last three years i.e. FY2021-22, FY2020-21, FY2019-20) of **Thirty Percent (30%) of Estimated Amount.**
- d) The bidders shall have Working Capital preceding the year of bid submission i.e. FY 2021-22 shall not be less than **Thirty Percent (30%) of Estimated Amount.**
- e) In case documents certifying credit facility from a scheduled Bank is submitted, the requirement given in 3(c) above shall be judged by adding available credit facility and working capital taken together. The statement displaying cash credit limits should not be more than three (03) months old as on the last date for submission of bids.
- f) Annual Audited Financial Report and IT returns along with related enclosures for last 3 (three) financial years (i.e. FY 2019-20 to 2021-22) to be submitted for verification in respect of bidders for whom audit of accounts is mandatory. For those whose audit of accounts is not mandatory, they shall also submit copy of IT returns along with related enclosures (Form 3CA and Form 3CB) for last three years (i.e. FY 2019-20 to 2021-22)
- g) The prospective Bidders or any of their constituent partner shall neither have abandoned any work nor any of their contract have been rescinded during the last 5 (five) years. Such abandonment or rescission will be considered as disqualification towards eligibility. (A declaration in this respect has to be furnished by the prospective bidders). [Non-statutory Documents]
- h) All categories of prospective Bidders shall have to submit valid copies of current Professional Tax payment Certificate, E.P.F. Registration certificate, Final GST Registration no, PAN Card and Income Tax Return for last three financial years (i.e. FY2021-22, FY 2020-21 & FY 2019-20), Trade License in respect of the prospective Bidder, viz Proprietorship Firm -Trade License, Partnership Firm -Partnership Deed, Trade License, Company -Incorporation certificate, Co-operative Society Trade License, Society Registration copy, trade License.

### 4. OTHER QUALIFICATION CRITERIA:

- i) The bidder should be bona-fide, experienced & resourceful Proprietorship Firm/company registered under Companies Act, 2013/ read with Companies Act, 1956 (with amendment from time to time) or Partnership Firm registered as per Indian Partnership Act, 1932, LLP registered under LLP Act, 2008 barring Government Department as well as foreign bidders/ MNCs not registered and incorporated in India and those bidders, already placed under holiday listing and the term/ duration of such listing has not yet expired.
- ii) A bidder shall not have a conflict of interest. Any bidders found to be having a conflict of interest shall be disqualified. The bidder shall be considered to have conflict of interest with one or more parties in this bidding process, if:
  - a. They have a controlling partner in common; or



- b. They receive or have received any direct or indirect subsidy from any of them: or
- c. They have the same legal representative for purpose of this bid; or
- d. They have a relationship with each other, directly or through common third parties, that puts them in position to have access to information about or influence on the bid of another bidder, or influence the decisions of the employer regarding this bidding process; or
- e. A bidder submits more than one bid in the bidding process, either individually or in any form, will result in disqualification of all such bids; or
- f. A bidder or any of its affiliates participated as a consultant in the preparation of the design or technical specification of the materials and services/works that are subject of the bid; or
- g. The bidder, directly or indirectly shall not be a dependent agency of the WBSEDCL.
- iii) The bidder should not have been banned / de-listed / black listed / debarred from business by any PSU / Govt. Department/WBSEDCL/WBSETCL or any other authorized institution.

Self-declaration in this regard is to be submitted as per Annexure –IV. Bids of only those Bidders who are meeting the Eligibility Criteria specified above will be considered for evaluation and award of the Contract. Bidders will submit requisite supporting documents and testimonials with their Bids to prove their credentials and claim of meeting the Eligibility Criteria.

#### Note:

- Mere downloading of Bid document by prospective bidder shall not be construed that such a bidder automatically fulfils the prescribed eligibility criteria. Whether the bidder meets the specific eligibility criteria or not, shall be checked or ascertained after opening their bids by scrutinizing documentary evidences furnished by them along with their bid.
- The Employer reserves the right to:
- Amend the scope of work to be tendered.
- ightharpoonup Reject or accept any bid for reasons including national defense and security consideration; and
- Earcel the bidding process and reject all bids, without assigning any reasons thereof. The Employer will not be liable for any such actions. However, the bidder(s), who wish to seek reasons for such decision of cancellation / rejection, shall be informed of the same by Employer unless its disclosure reasonably could be expected to affect the sovereignty and integrity of India; the security, strategic, scientific or economic interest of the State; relation with foreign state or lead to incitement of an offence.
- 5. The Financial Offer of the prospective bidder will be considered only if the Technical Bid of the Bidder is found qualified by the WBSEDCL. The decision of the WBSEDCL will be final and absolute in this respect. The list of Qualified Bidders of Technical Bid will be displayed in the website.
- 6. Mobilization advance and secured advance will not be allowed.

7. Bid shall remain valid for a period not less than 180 (one hundred eighty) days from the date of opening of Price Bid. If the bidder modifies/withdraws the bid during the validity period of bid, the bid will be cancelled with forfeiture of Earnest Money Deposit (EMD).

The cost of visiting the site shall be at the Bidder's own expense. Before submission of the bid, Bidders are requested to make themselves fully conversant with the site conditions, labourer conditions, specifications, schedules, drawings and other information so that no ambiguity may arise in these respects subsequent to the submission of the tender. Representative of the Bidders should visit the sites to assess the site conditions prior to submission of bid.
- The intending Bidders shall clearly understand that whatever may be the outcome of the present invitation of Bids, no cost of Bidding shall be reimbursable by the WBSEDCL. The WBSEDCL reserves the right to accept or reject any offer without assigning any reason whatsoever and is not liable for any cost that might have been incurred by any Bidder at any stage of Bidding.
- 11. Prospective applicants are advised to note carefully the minimum qualification criteria as mentioned in 'Eligibility Criteria' before bidding the tender.
- 12. Exemption from deposition of Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) shall not be allowed under any circumstances.
- 13. Conditional / Incomplete tender will not be accepted under any circumstances.
- 14. The intending Bidders are required to quote the rate online only.
- During scrutiny, if it comes to the notice of the tender inviting authority that the credential or any other paper found incorrect / manufactured / fabricated, that bidder would not be allowed to participate in the tender and the application will be rejected without any prejudice.

ITB.1 GENERAL GUIDANCE FOR E-TENDERING:

ITB.3 DIGITAL SIGNATURE CERTIFICATE (DSC):

Each contractor is required to obtain a Class-II or Class-III Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) for submission of tenders from the approved service provider of the National Informatics Centre (NIC) on payment of requisite amount. Details are available at the Web Site stated above. DSC is given as a USB e-

General process of submission:

Tenders are to be submitted online along with all necessary documents, as asked for in the tender to the website stated in above, in two folders at a time, one in Technical Proposal and the other is Financial Proposal before the prescribed date and time using Digital Signature Certificate (DSC). The Bidder shall carefully go through the documents and prepare the required documents and upload the scanned documents in Portable Document Format (PDF) to the portal in the designated locations. The bidder needs to download the standardized Forms / Annexure, fill up the particulars in the designated Cell and upload the same in the designated location of Technical Bid. He needs to download the BOQ, fill up the rates of items in the BOQ in the designated Cell and upload the same in the designated location of Financial Bid. The documents uploaded shall be virus scanned and digitally signed using the Digital Signature Certificate (DSC). The uploaded Documents will get encrypted (transformed into non readable formats).

All the documents uploaded by the Tender Inviting Authority form an integral part of the contract. Bidder should take note of all the addendum/corrigendum related to the tender and upload the latest digitally signed documents as part of
