For execution of said work, WBSEDCL will supply major part of materials & equipments which will be issued from Diamond Harbour divisional store.

Terms & Conditions of the E-Tender:

In the event of e-filing intending bidder may download the tender document from the website https://wbtenders.gov.in directly with the help of Digital Signature Certificate.

- a. A bidder desirous of taking part in the tender invited by Offices of WBSEDCL shall login to the e-Procurement portal of Government of West Bengal https://wbtenders.gov.in using his login Id and password.
- b. The bidder shall select the tender to bid and initiate payment of EMD. Following payment options are available for paying EMD amount through online mode:
 - i. Net banking through Payment Gateway.

- ii. RTGS/NEFT payment: On selection of RTGS/NEFT as the payment mode, the e-Procurement portal will show a pre-filled challan having the details of process RTGS/NEFT transaction. The bidder will print the challan and use the pre-filled information to make RTGS/NEFT payment using his bank account. Once the payment is made, the bidder will come back to the e- procurement portal to continue the bidding process after expiry of a reasonable time to enable the RTGS/NEFT process to be completed.
- c. Partial payment through online mode and remaining submission through BG is not allowed.

d. General Instruction for online payment:

> The bidder will have to mandatorily pay through Net-banking facility once Net- banking mode is

opted for payment.

> Status of NEFT/RTGS payment through challan for a bid may take time for bank settlement which is updated in 24 Hrs. (Approx.). As such bidders opting to pay through NEFT/RTGS mode shall make payment well before 24 Hrs. to avoid any complicacy.

In case actual EMD amount as per NIT is more than the one shown in E- tender portal, bidders will have to opt for NEFT/RTGS mode (Challan Mode). In that case the total actual EMD amount id to be

paid only through NEFT/RTGS mode (Challan Mode).

- > The bank account used for payment by the bidders shall be maintained operative until the completion of the tendering process. All refunds will be maintained mandatorily to the bank A/C from which the payment has been initiated.
- e. Refund / Settlement of EMD Amount:
 - > For unsuccessful bidders, EMD amount submitted against the tender shall be refundable automatically, through an automated process, by NIC portal on receipt of updated status of any bid.

> For successful bid(s),EMD will be refundable from WBSEDCL authority after completion of tendering

process and following due procedures.

- > The bank account used for payment of EMD by the bidders shall be maintained operative until the completion of tendering process. All refunds will be made mandatorily to the bank A/C from which the payment of EMD has been initiated.

Technical Document and Financial Bid should be submitted online on or before as per the Date & Time Schedule" statedinSl.No.-07.The FINANCIAL OFFER of the prospective tenderer will be considered only if the TECHNICAL DOCUMENT of the tenderer found qualified by the Tender Inviting Authority. The decision of the Tender Inviting Authority will be final and absolute in this respect. The list of Responsive and Non-Responsive Bidders will be displayed in the website. - 2. Both Technical Bid and Financial Bid should be submitted in technical and financial folder concurrently duly digitally signed by the Tenderer through the website https://wbtenders.gov.in.

- 3. Neither prospective Bidder nor any of the constituent partners had been debarred to participate in any Tender by any Government Department/Semi-Govt./Govt. Undertakings/ Enterprise etc. during the last 5 (five) years prior to the date of this NIT. Such debarring will be considered as disqualification towards eligibility. (A declaration in this respect has to be furnished by the prospective bidders). [Non-statutory Documents]
- 4. The prospective Bidders or any of their constituent partner shall neither have abandoned any work nor any of their contract have been rescinded during the last 5 (five) years. Such abandonment or rescission will be considered as disqualification towards eligibility. (A declaration in this respect has to be furnished by the prospective bidders). [Non-statutory Documents]
- No conditional / Incomplete Tender will be accepted under any circumstances.
- 6. The FINANCIAL OFFER of the prospective bidder will be considered only if the TECHNICAL BID of the Bidder is found qualified by the WBSEDCL. The decision of the WBSEDCL will be final and absolute in this respect. The list of Qualified Bidders of Technical Bid will be displayed in the website.

- If a Holiday falls on any of the aforesaid scheduled date then scheduled date shall be considered on next working day.
- 2. Bid validation: Bids shall remain valid for a period not less than 180 (One hundred Eighty) days after date of Bid opening of tender. Bid valid for a shorter period shall be rejected by the Tender Inviting Authority as non-

responsive. If the tenderer withdraws the bid before the period of bid validity without giving any satisfactory explanation for such withdrawals, the earnest money as deposited will be forfeited forthwith without assigning any reason thereof.

- 3. Earnest Money: The amount of the Earnest Money for each package @ 2% of Estimated Cost of each package as mentioned in Package Summary. The bid guarantee shall be valid for 180 (One Hundred Eighty) days with a claim period up to 3 months from the date of opening of bid. Earnest Money of the unsuccessful Bidder will be released after finalization of tender against the prayer of the contractor. No interest shall be payable by WBSEDCL on the above amount. Exemption from deposition of EMD shall not be allowed under any circumstances. No Interest shall be payable by WBSEDCL on the above bid guarantee.
- 4. Security Deposit: In respect of successful bidder, the Earnest Money after acceptance of Tender shall be converted as a part of the security deposit. The successful bidder who deposited Earnest Money, balance of necessary security deposit which is 10% of value of work shall be realized from the progressive bill amount of each such bill. In all cases the amount of recovery of the final bill will be so adjusted as to make the total amount of security deposit equivalent to 10 % value of work so executed.
- 5. The Bidder, at his own responsibility and risk is encouraged to visit and examine the site of works and its surroundings and obtained all information that may be necessary for preparing Bid and entering into an agreement for the work / works as mentioned in the NIT, before submitting offer with full satisfaction. The costs for visiting the working site shall be at the bidder own expense.
- 6. The intending Bidders shall clearly understand that whatever may be the outcome of the present invitation of the Bid, the Tender Inviting Authority reserves the right to accept or reject any / all offer without assigning any reason whatsoever and is not liable for any cost that might have incurred by the Bidder at the stage of Bidding.
- 7. Prospective applicants are advised to note carefully the minimum qualification criteria as mentioned in Instruction to bidders stated in Section-"A" before tendering the bids.
- 8. Work Order & Payment of work will be depended on availability of fund. Intending bidders may consider this criteria while submission of tender and quoting their rate through online.
- 9. No Conditional Bid / Incomplete Tender will be accepted under any circumstances.
- 10. At any stage during scrutiny, if it is found that the credential or any other papers which the Bidder uploaded during Bidding process, found incorrect / manufactured / fabricated, that bid will be considered a nonresponsive and outright rejected with forfeiture of Earnest Money and action will be taken as per stipulation of IT Rules in force.
- 11. Before issuance of Letter of Acceptance / Work order, the tender accepting authority may verify the credential& other documents of the lowest bidder so uploaded online if found necessary. If it is found such document incorrect / manufactured / fabricated, Letter of Acceptance / Work order will not be issued in favor of the bidder under any circumstances and action will be taken accordingly.
- 12. TheTenderInvitingAuthorityreservesthe right tocanceltheNITduetounavoidablecircumstancesandnoclaim in this respect will be entertained. The company shall no way be held responsible or liable for any accident, mishap of any worker during the execution of the work, any loss or damage cause to any equipment's of WBSEDCL during execution shall have to be compensated in full as per direction of the Tender Inviting Authority.
- 13. Standard safety norms as prescribed in the rules and regulations of WBSEDCL have to be religiously followed.
- 14. Penalty of ½ % per week of delay or part thereof subject to maximum of 2.5 % of the each ordered value will be charged on the bill for non-completion of work in time. The mobile number of the bidders has to be mentioned.
- 15. The bidders need to have necessary electrical license and documents, obtained from the Appropriate Authority, to execute work of mentioned voltage grade.

18. Any bidder against whom FIR/Complaint is lodged with Police by WBSEDCL shall not be eligible to participate in the bidding process.

19. If the offer is submitted without or inadequate Earnest Money, the bid will not be opened. In case of incomplete offer, the tender will be liable for rejection and Earnest Money Deposit will be forfeited.

20. Any evidence of unfair Trade Practices including overcharging, price fixing, cartel etc. as defined in various statutes, will automatically disqualify the bidders.

WBSEDCL reserves the right to reject or accept any Bid or part thereof or all Bids received at its sole discretion without assigning any reason (s) whatsoever.

2. WBSEDCL is not necessarily bound to accept the lowest offer.

3. Submission of Bidding Documents will not be construed to mean that such bidder is automatically considered qualified.

4. Tender submitted after expiry of scheduled date and time shall not be considered.

7. Any extraneous conditions will be treated as non-responsive.

8. The Bids must be submitted in prescribed pro forma only.

- 9. Formation of any Cartel, may lead to the cancellation of tenders with period measures as necessary and WBSEDCL reserves the right to take such unilateral decisions without further notice to anyone.
- 10. Bidders shall ensure that all pre-requisites are duly fulfilled by them and if there be any dispute regarding nonsubmission of any document, WBSEDCL reserves the right to cancel the Bid unilaterally without assigning any reasons whatsoever.

PAYMENT: 90% payment of Progressive R/A bills against the prayer of the contractor, for an amount of minimum 20 % of the ordered value or as deemed justified by the controlling officer shall be released against certification by the controlling officer after deducting the amount already paid or other amounts as may be deductible. The bills shall be released within 30(thirty) days from submission of bill in triplicate against Original Tax Invoice/receipt, JMC, Material Consumption Statements and other relevant documents duly authenticated by the competent authority of WBSEDCL. The final bill shall be released on completion of the work in all respect and fulfilment of all contractual obligations by the contractor.
